My most recent achievement was making the rugbyPA all-state team, and being able to play with a group of very talented girls. Of course there are always challenges that come along with playing sports. There have been many times



I started the U11 season as an attacking midfielder, scoring 3 goals and 18 assists.


Recently I have found a passion for Goalkeeping and this is now what I want to do.


I have currently played two games in goal and training has been going really well.



let's me meet loads of different people from around the country! I also want to create a better future for all of the future ballers around and tackle important subjects like racism.










