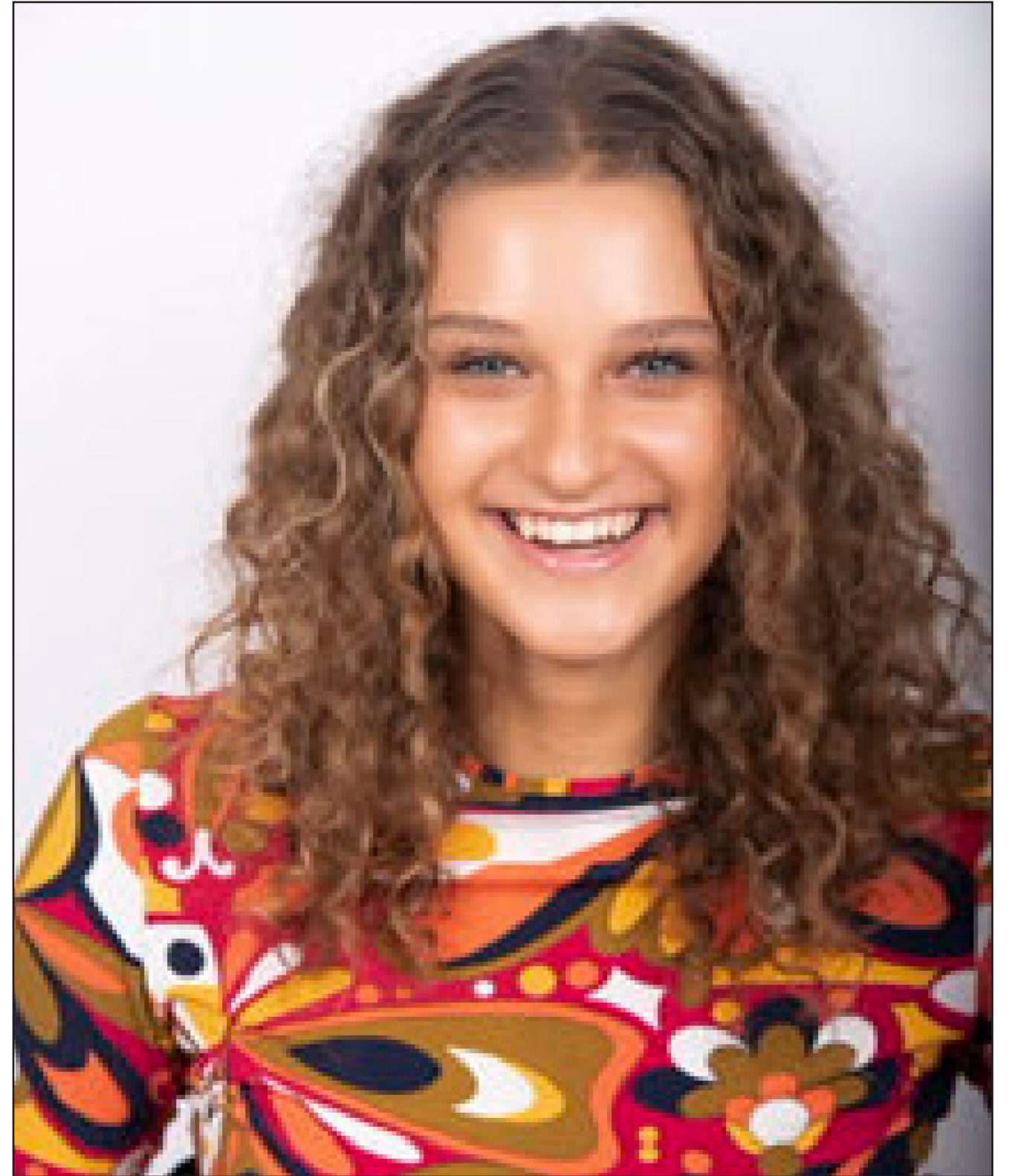
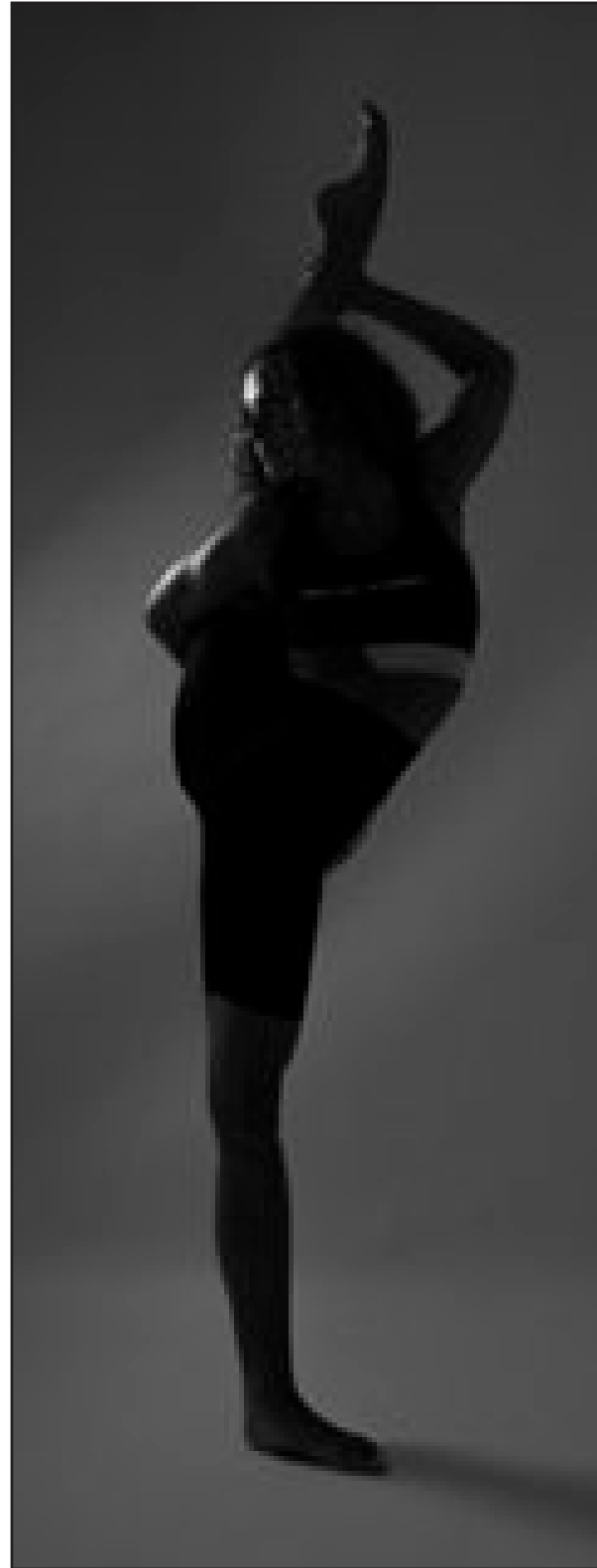


Brigita Kvedaraite

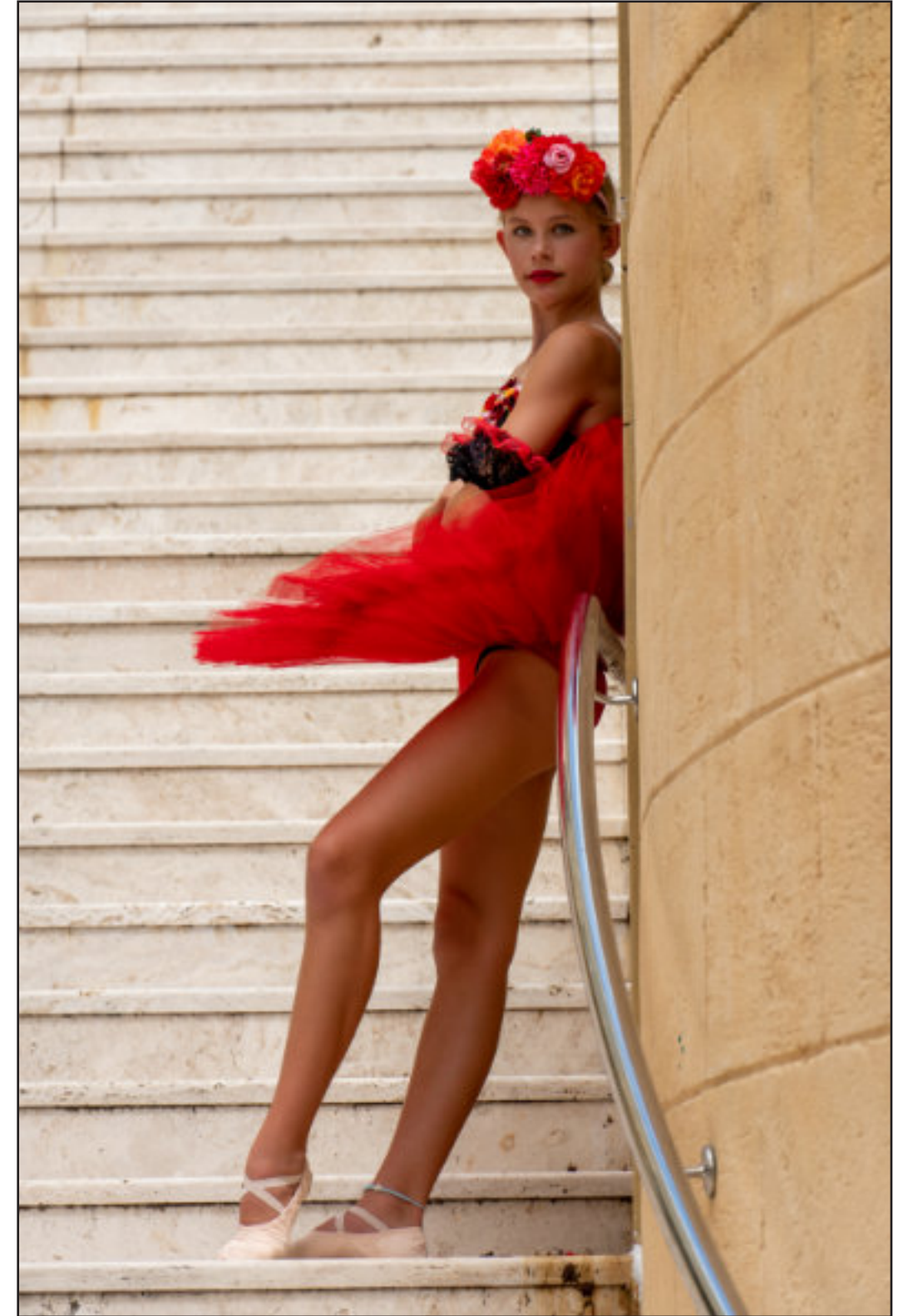
I love the feeling of performing - dance makes me happy!

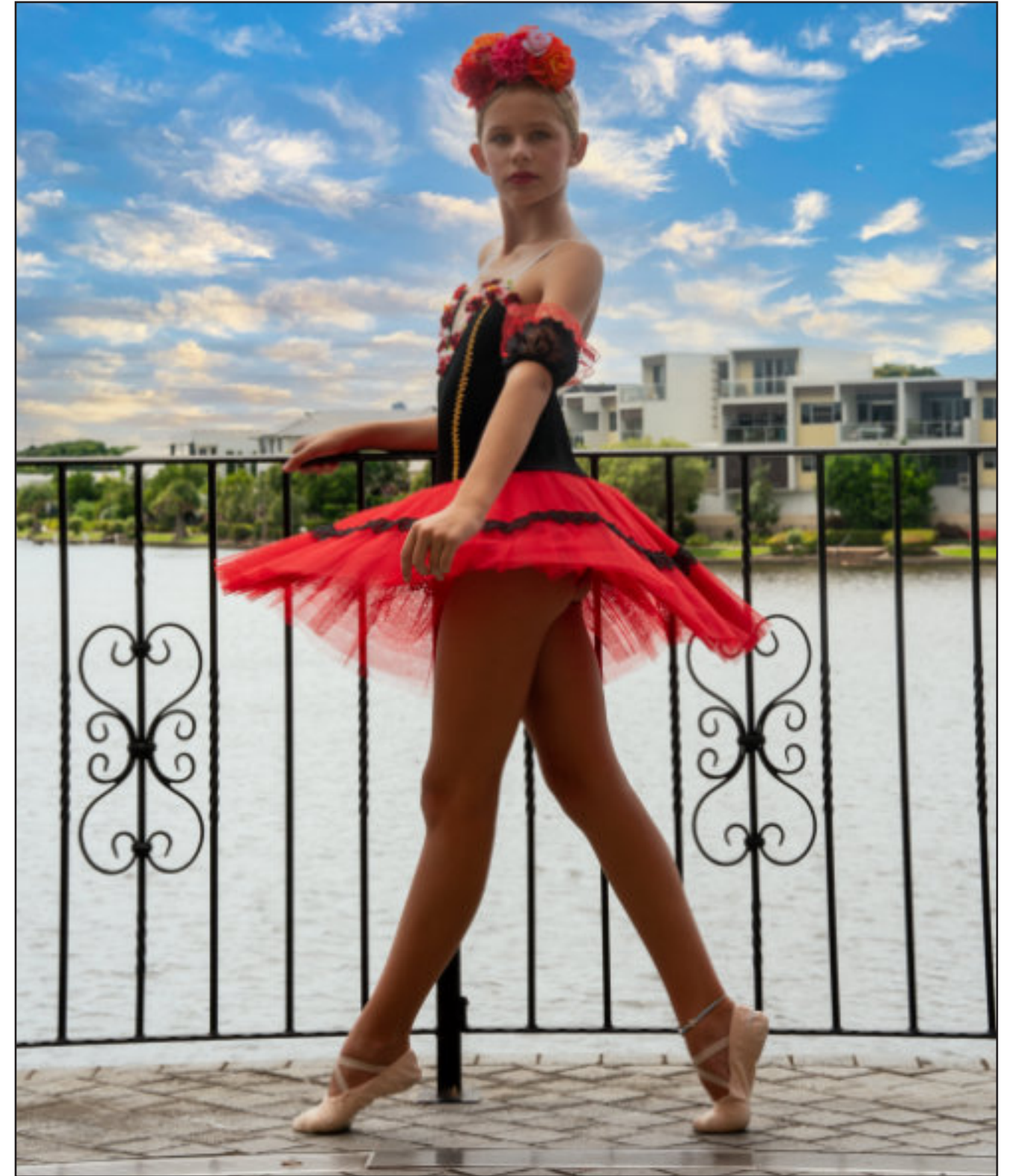

I already help out with three dance classes a week teaching 5 - 6 year olds and I love it so much.

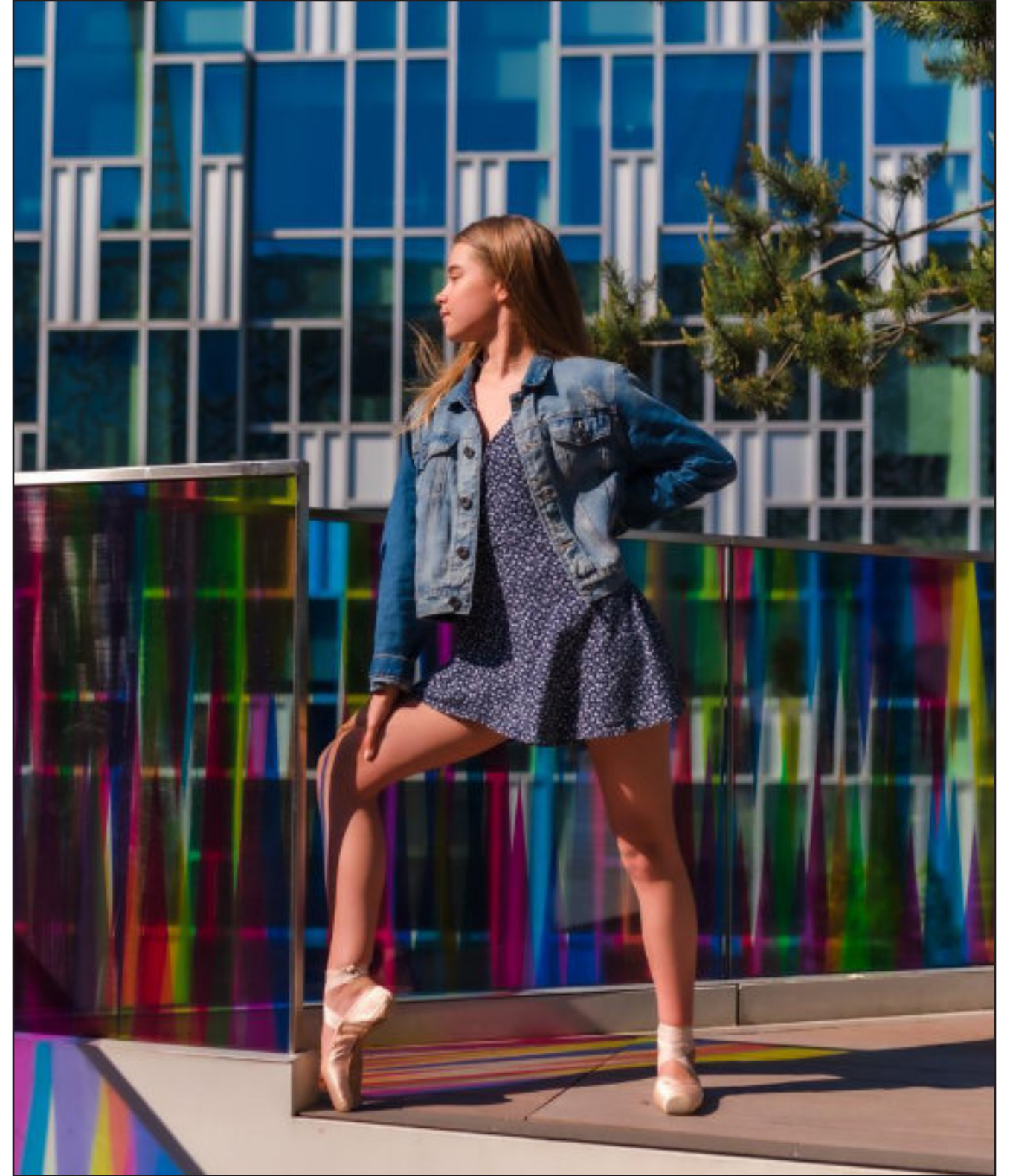
I am looking forward to what dance will bring me this year.

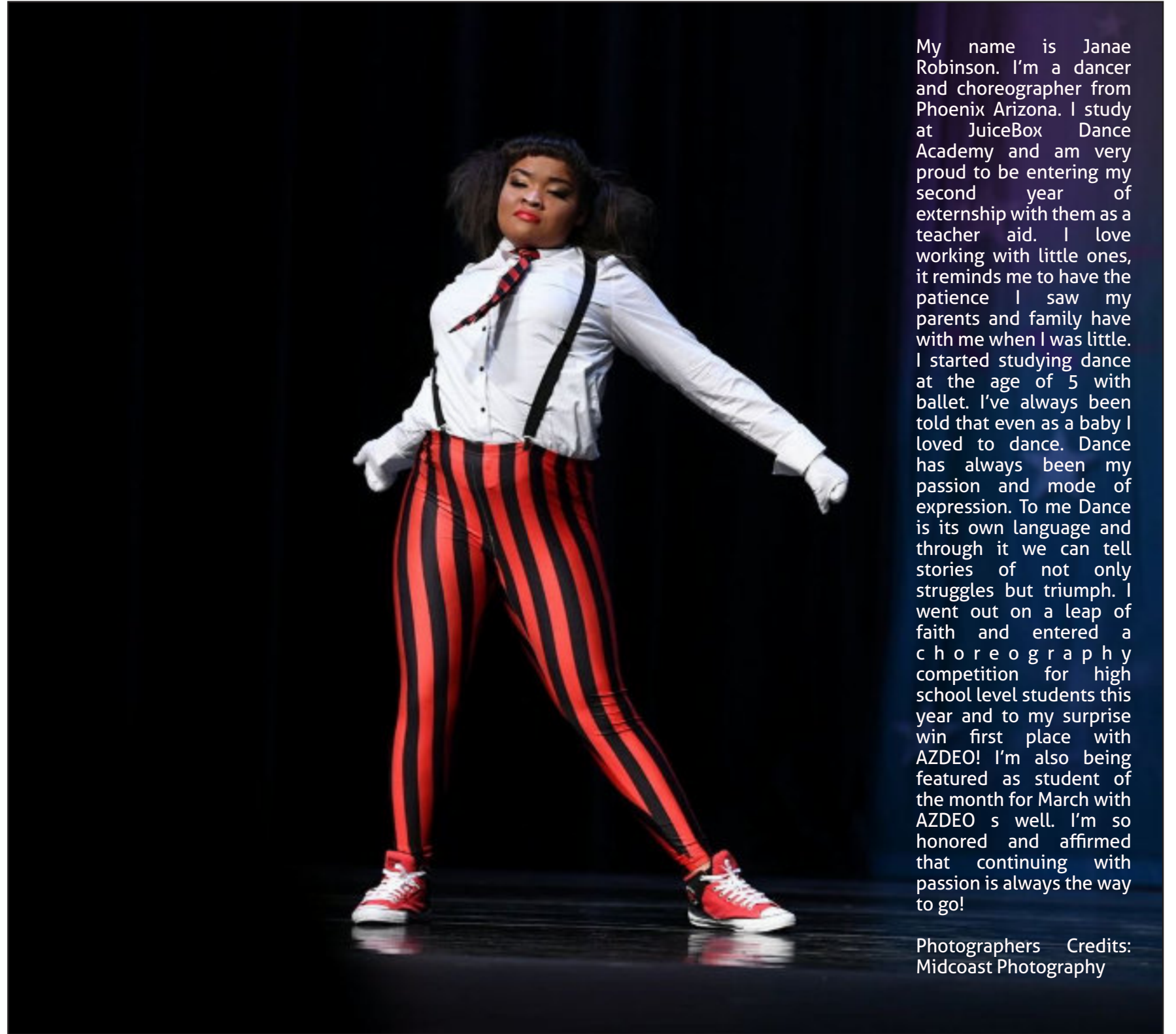

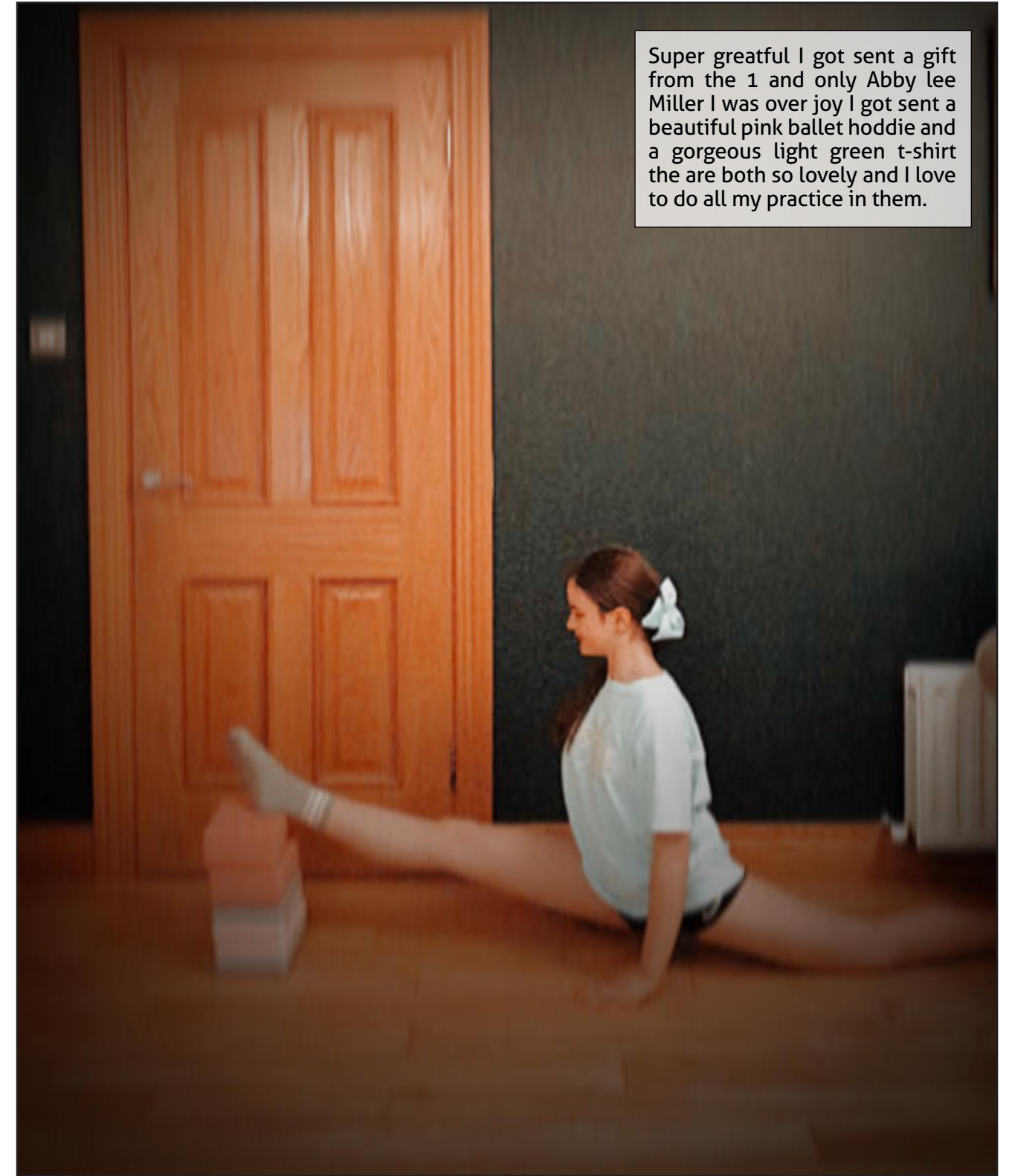
Janae Robinson



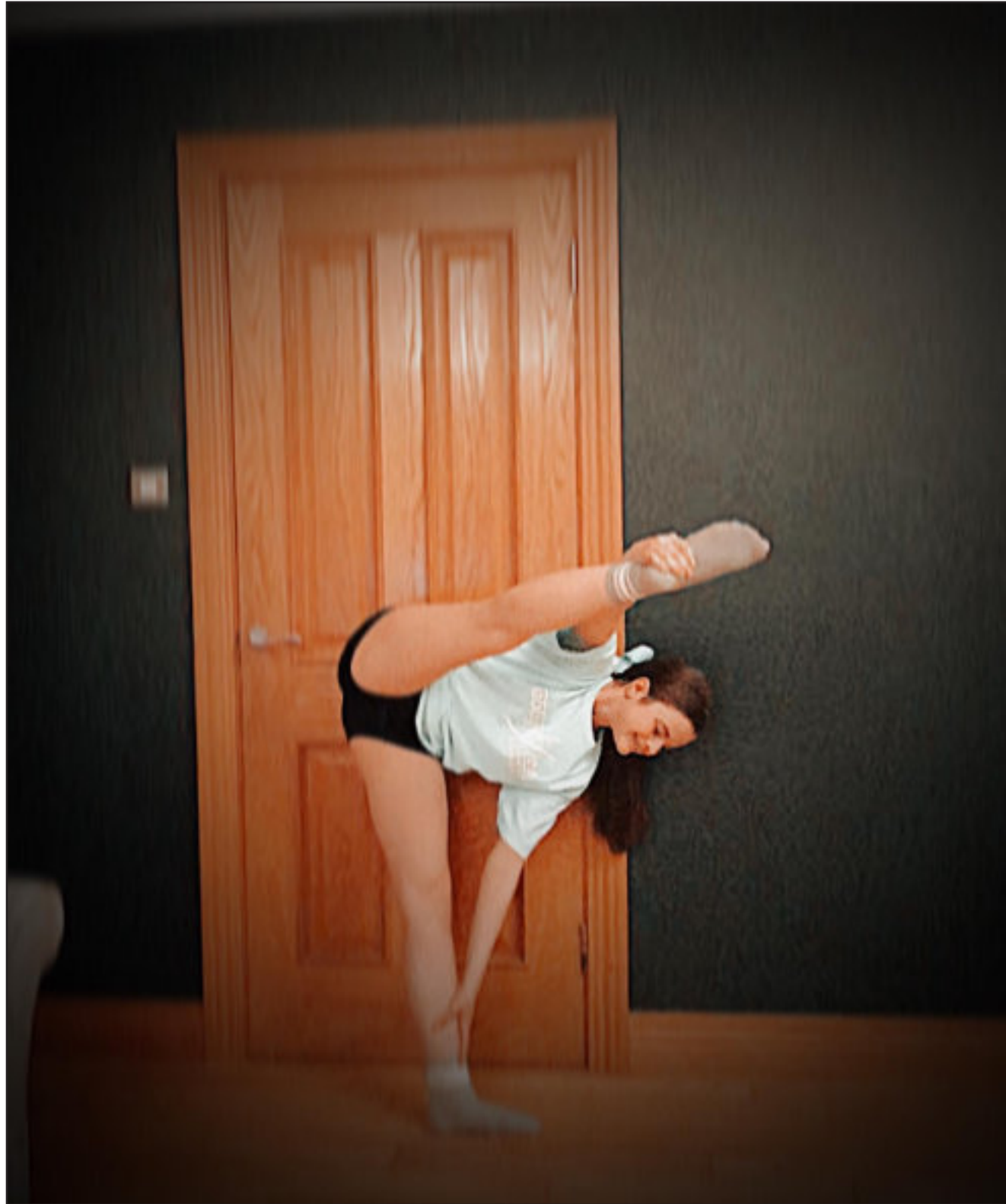

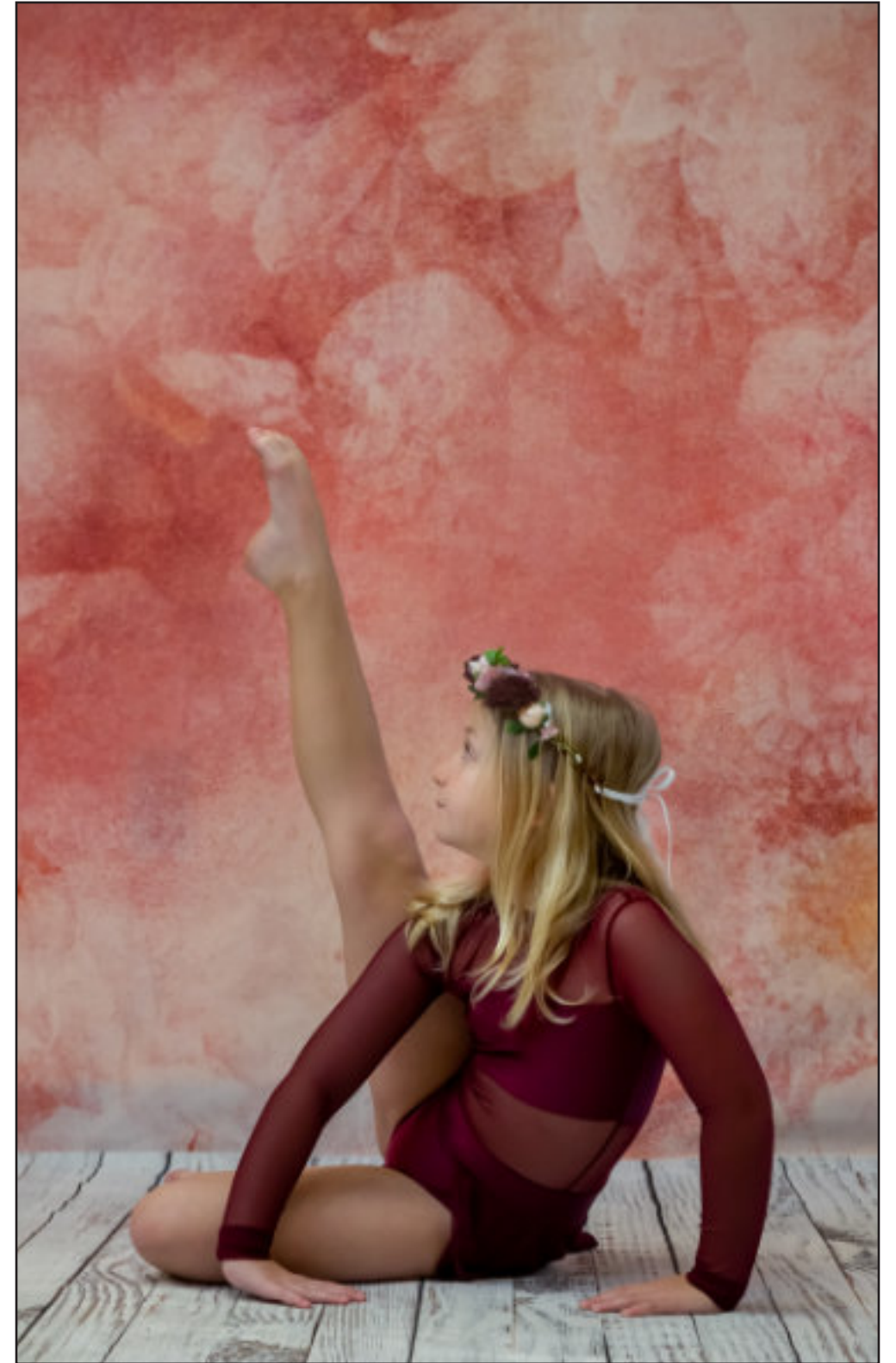
