Nebenbei werde ich voraussichtlich in drei Jahren mein Abitur abschließen.

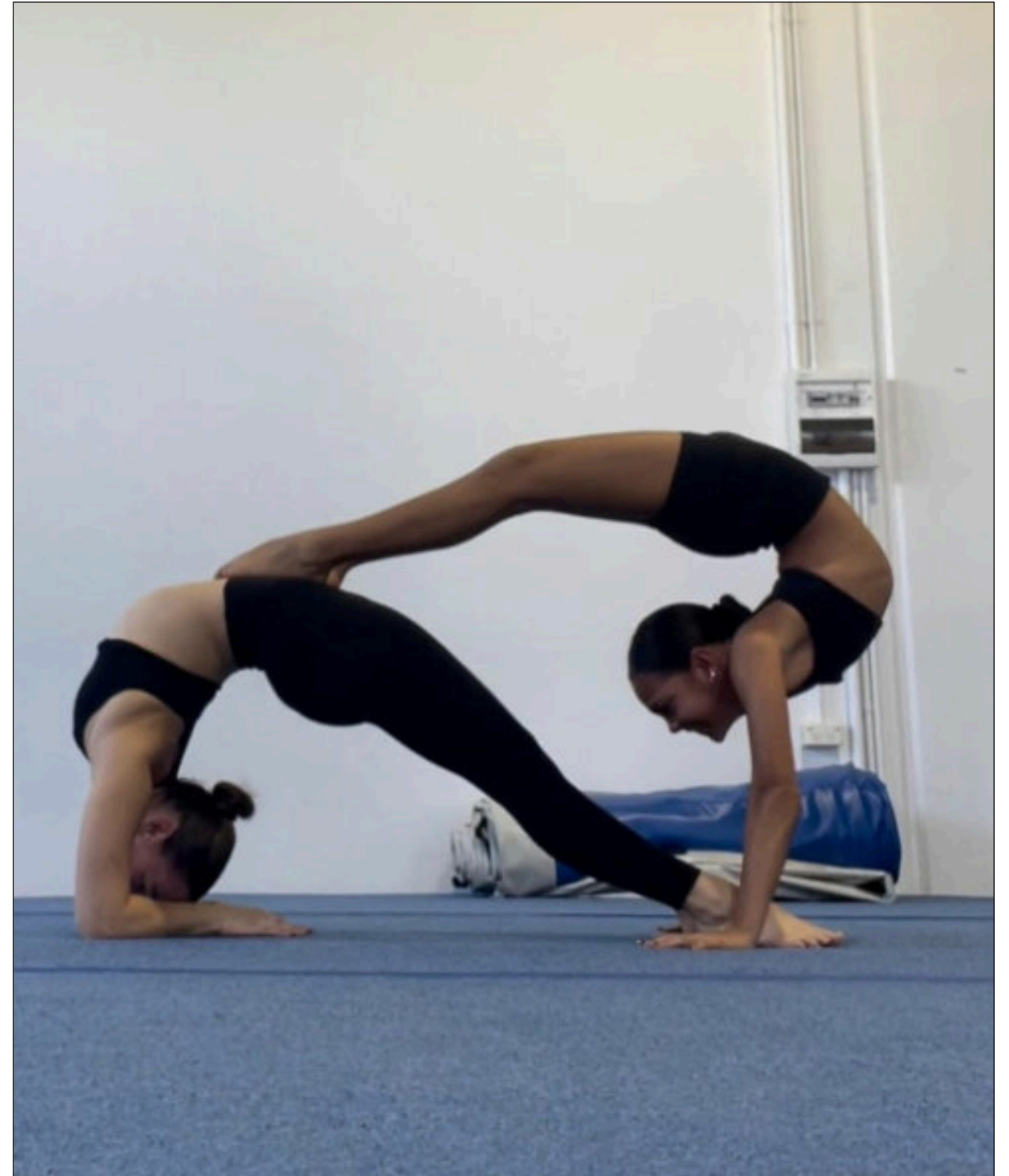
Ich bin gespannt, was ich alles noch erleben darf und wie sich alles entwickeln wird.

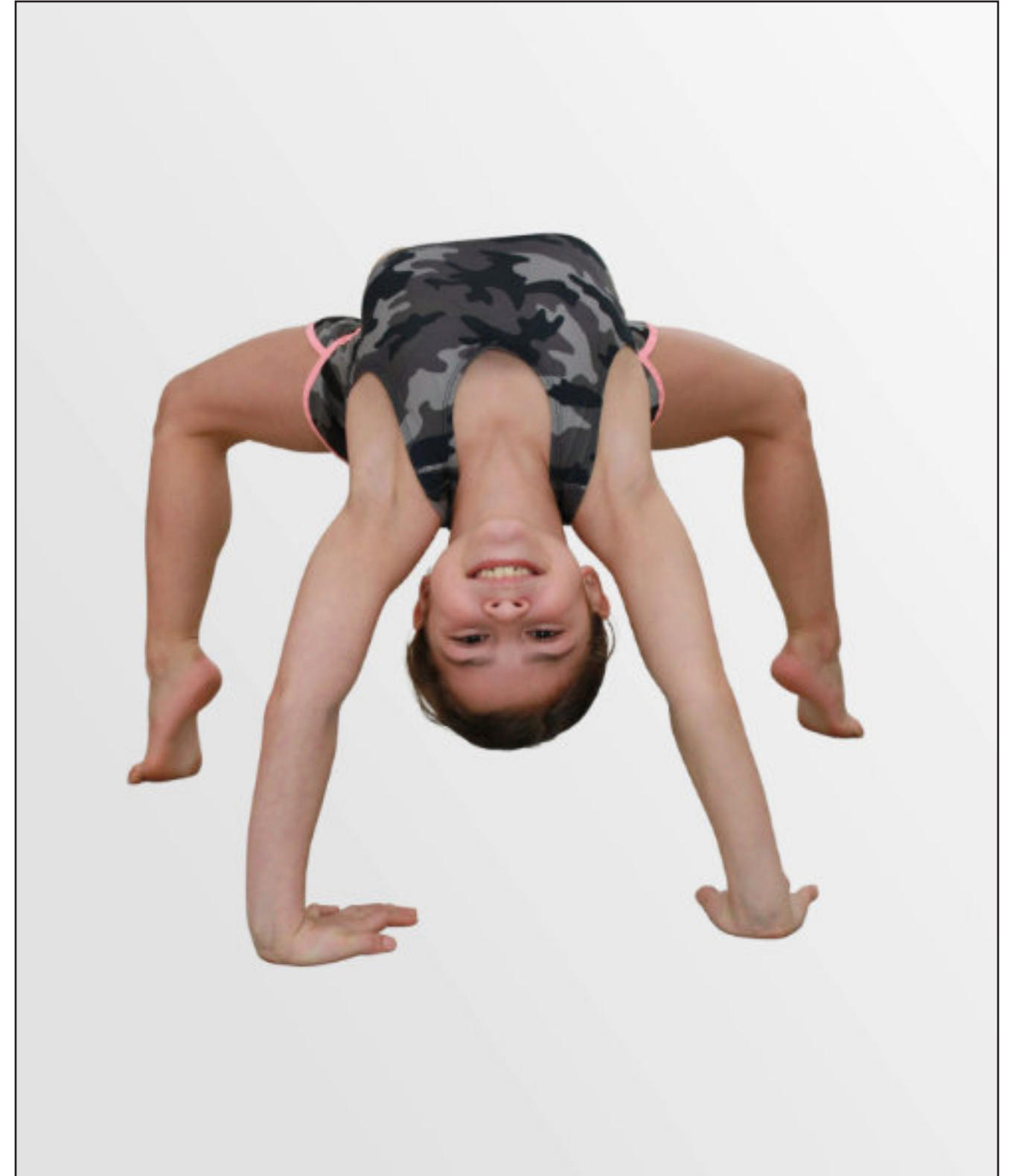






My name is Lily, I live in Australia. I train hard, want to be a professional gymnast.

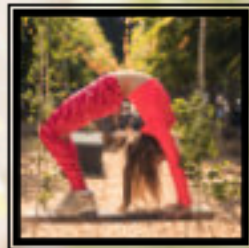
