

































Michael LeDonne - Age 10, began Jujitsu at 4 years old.








Sensei's Shidoshi Ron the Black Dragon Van Clief & Shidoshi Glenn Perry is the art of Taikyokuken Ken Sho Ryu which translated means the hard ϑ soft principles of Chinese & Japanese. Shidoshi's overall total statistics in competitions is 850 competitions under his belt are classified as:776 wins, with only 2 losses. The difference of 72 comes from Honorable mentions which in today's

World are considered 4th places & actually wins but being from the old school of learning he doesn't consider these honorable 4th places as wins. He has been inducted into The Halls of Fame both Nationally & Internationally from The Virgin Islands, London, Poland, India, & Argentina. Most recently Shidoshi Faraday was inducted into the Ultimate Warriors Hall of Fame on February 18th, 2022, by Legends Sifu Al Dacascos & Shidoshi Ron Van Clief. 




