My name is Joseph. I am 13 years old from England. It's been 4 years now since I started playing the game and I must say that my game has improved a lot over the period of time. There

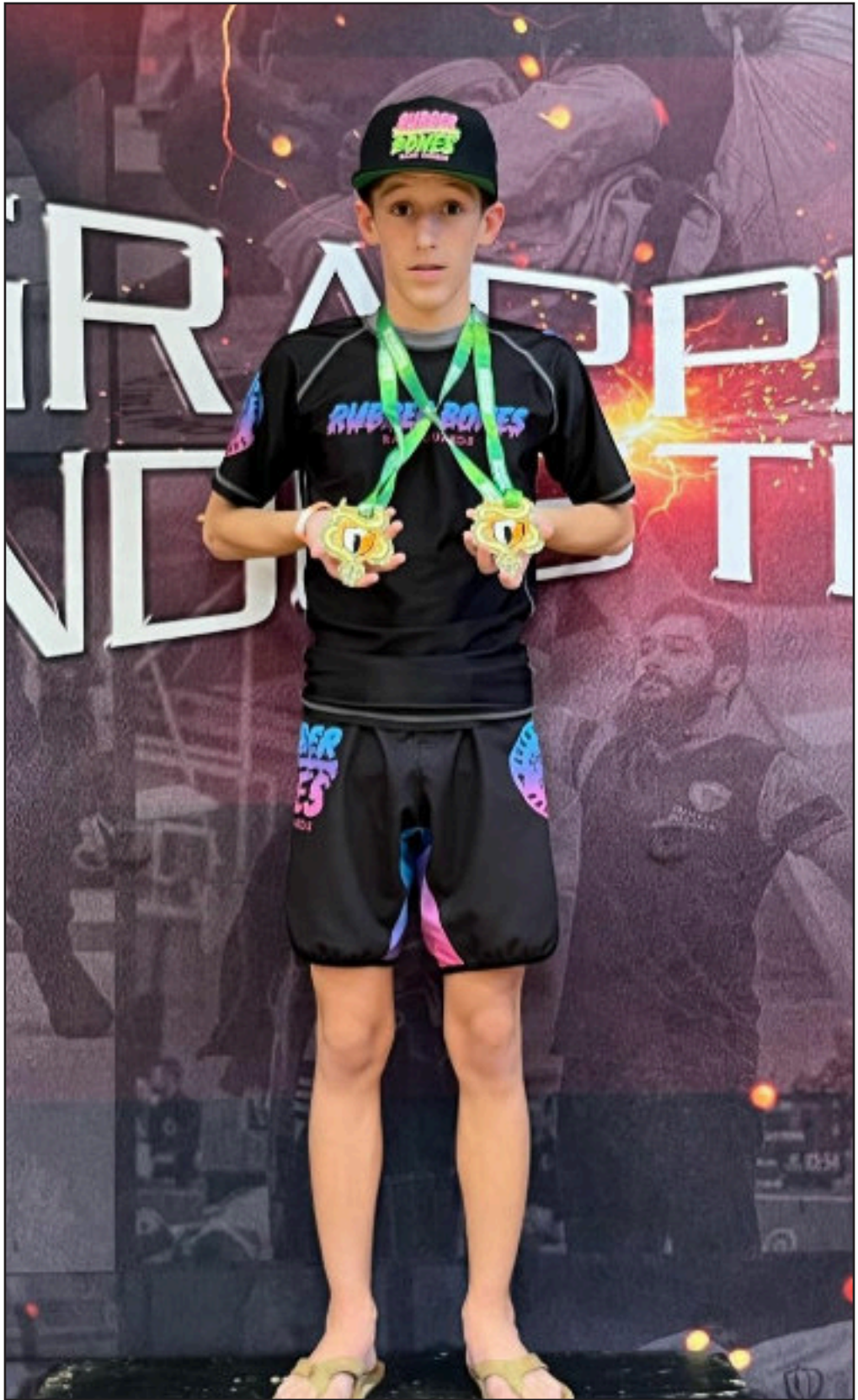
has been many wins, defeats everything but that doesn't matter. What matters is the learnings which I got because of the game which will help me tackling my future challenges.

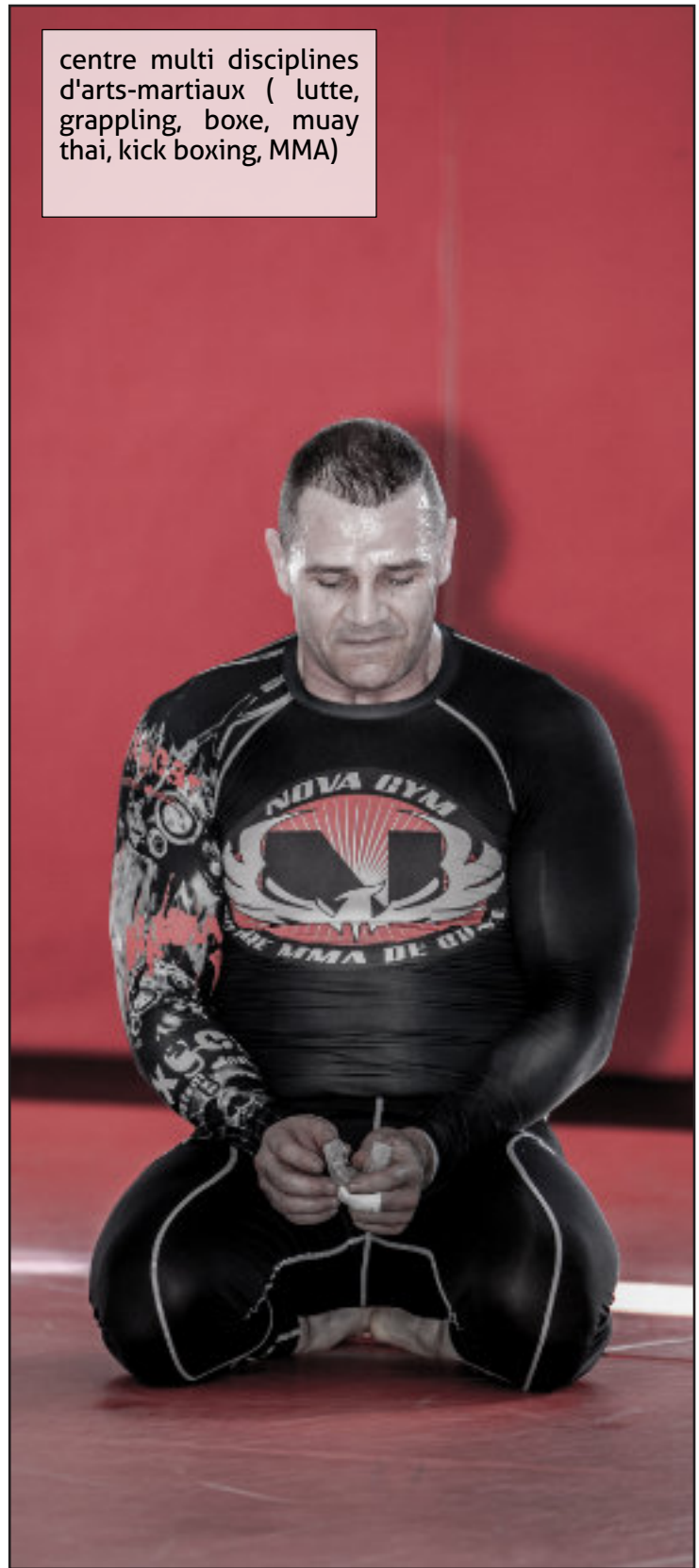

Background

-Ollie is 15, turning 16 on August 17th 2023 and currently completing Year 9 in Sydney at St Aloysius college in milsons point.

-He has just won the youth World Championships Jiu-Jitsu 2022 held in Abu Dhabi in the highest division, 15yo, Open weight, Green belt where he fought the best competitors in the world.

-In 2018 he won the World Championships in Abu Dhabi age 11

-He also won Kids World Jiu-Jitsu Championships in California in 2015 at the age of 8

-2023 will be the year Oliver turns 16 so he will be permitted to compete against adults under ibjjf (international Brazilian jiu jitsu federation)

regulations. In Jan 2023 He will fight in the European championships in paris france, then on may 31st he will fight in the ibjjf world championships at the Walter pyramid long beach California as a juvenile adult.

I first attempted to start Ollie at 3 years old but the coaches laughed and said bring him back when he's 6, we returned next year when he was 4 and told them he was 6 and they accepted him, 1 year later at the age of 5 he started competing. his first competition he fought an older, heavier and more experienced competitor but still won the match against all odds

Ollie's first major win was the NSW state championships in 2014 in that same year he continued on to win the most prestigious events in Australia, The Australian Championship and Pacific Championships this year marked the start

of his 8 year undefeated/undisputed winning streak at these tournaments bringing his total to:

8x State Champion

8x Australian Champion

7x Pan Pacific Champion (cancelled 1 year due to covid)

Olivers skill level in jiu jitsu has become so advanced that we needed to tailor his training with specific instructors which required us to travel all over Australia. We have since opened our own gym, High Rollers jiu jitsu where we fly in the most talented high level instructors available and create classes for high level athletes.

This year alone High Rollers jiu jitsu has produced 15 Australian champions 9 pan Pacific champions and 4 world champions in their respective

divisions.

Noteworthy achievements:

Only junior Australian to ever be invited to participate in an adults invitational only superfight tournament where he won in spectacular style via flying triangle submission.

8 year undefeated winning steak at State championships, Pan Pacific and Australian championships

First Australian junior to win Via Leg attack submission

First Australian junior to not only have fought adults but also won against them starting at age 14.

Recently Grappling Nationals held an open weight



superfight even for juvenile adults which were older, heavier and higher ranking than Ollie.

This tournament drew the best juveniles adults in the country due to the prize on offer, airfares to compete in the world championships for the winner.

After some deliberation and signing of waivers, Grappling nationals agreed to let Ollie compete.

Much to everyone's surprise, he won the event and used that airfare for his trip to Abu Dhabi.

The above mentioned tournament are the highlights only, Ollie has won over 300 Competition matches over the years

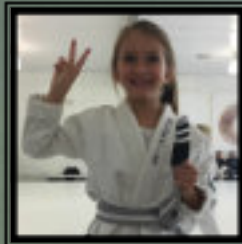
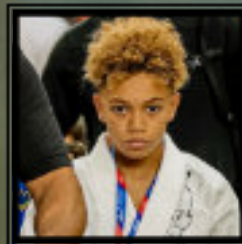
