My mid term goal is to achieve a green belt by the time I'm 14. I know this will require huge amount of training and dedication and I'm up for a challenge.




In a short term I really want to focus on my training. I want to improve my physical strength and gain technical ability in all areas of my game.





In the Martial Science reflections to who is the mainstream as one of the leading pioneers today is the name Soke Michael P. Faraday. A senior member to not only the Chinese Goju Family, but also to the Black Dragon Aiki-Jutsu Family.

He has learned from legends of our times having Shidoshi Ron 'The Black Dragon", Shidoshi Glenn Perry, Shodia Alan D' Allessandro, Hanshi Wayne Mello, Sifu Ruben Rodrigues as his Sensei's, & has trained with such greats in the industry as Grandmaster's Cynthia Rothrock, the Late & influential Prof. Dr. Sri Dinesh, Mark Shuey better known as the Cane Master, Jeff Speakman "The Perfect Weapon.", Oso Tayari Casel, Bill "Superfoot" Wallace, George Alexander, Kathy Long, Dan 'The Beast." Severn, & Shihan Dana Abbott just to name a few during Soke Faraday's 43 years involved in the Sciences of Martial Arts.

Soke Faraday is currently the founder of his system of Taikyokuken Ken Sho-Ryu as certified & acknowledged by not only Shidoshi Ron & Glenn, but also by the World head Masters Sokeship Council which Soke Faraday was also inducted into late last year. In the past he was not only a member being recruited onto the United States Martial Arts Team: Team America from the tournament located at the Boston State Championships at the Reggie Lewis Track & Field Center on Sept17th 1999, but also remained as a successful fierce competitor on this team without defeat until he retired in 2006 stepping down from his appointment for personal reasons regarding family life.



Soke was also one of the head coaches to the U.S. team which traveled International for the 2004 ~ 2006 years.

Remaining extremely busy still in all the arts as well as competition Soke Faraday has a documented record certified in his professional career with 890 wins with only two losses of which the 1st loss was in 1997 in Warwick RI, & the 2nd in 2020 in the country of Romania. His wins come from such leagues as:

The Naska, Krane, Adidas, Karate Athletes Rankings, World Showcase, Karate World Continental, The Master's, & The sport Karate also just to name but a few.


All of Soke Faraday's wins span across six continents, fifty different countries, & in his home country of the United States he has also won in twenty-two different States in America to date. Soke even entered a tournament that helped select athletes from his country in the States onto the Olympic roster too for which he made the top three at the age of 52.


This he said was for fun & to see if at the age he is now could still have what it took to be considered a top athlete for these games. So, after he found out & knew where he still stood he next relinquished his own spot so someone younger so they could have their change like he did back in 1999.

Soke Faraday is also an award-winning author with 35 different books available on amazon of which only this year he had published the following book's: "The Five Temples, The Darker side, The Breath of a Dragon, The Silver Bells of Christmas, The Art of Kenpo which he received best author of a Martial Arts Publication & was inducted into the International Martial Arts Hall of Fame.

This high honor was by Grandmaster Shi Heng Chang (Gajanand Rajput) in India, & on Dec. 30th of 2022 he just released another title called Blood of a Warrior too.

As said earlier Soke Michael P. Faraday has






been keeping really busy & just this past year he has won tournaments in Iran taking 5 Gold places, Poland with 3 Golds, 1 Silver, & 1 Bronze, Germany with 4 Golds, & 1 Bronze, United States with 2 Golds & 1 Silver, & 12 overall wins in Italy of various places.

He was also induced into the Ultimate Warrior Hall of Fame, in America International Martial Arts Hall of Fame, in India, he received the International Martial arts Award in Poland, & was inducted into the budo Bushi Hall of Fame also in

Poland. With over 35 different inductions into the Halls of Fame for various categories from lifetime achievements to esteemed Warrior, etc. in America; Soke Faraday has also been blessed to have been inducted into many of the Halls of Fame internationally too.

"London 2x, Argentina 2x, Italy 3x, & both Poland & India for a total of 7x each!"

In ending our 2023 interview with Soke Michael P. Faraday he says he wishes everyone great success





in all that they seek to accomplish & as for himself is going to keep on competing to see what he can achieve until he losses a total of three competitions. He then said that 3 losses is the magic retirement number for him, but really hope to make it to a staggering 1,000. Wins before he losses that 3rd time. If he can go past this too would be really awesome. His next competition is

for the Ronin world Championships in Poland where he has already produced his demos totaling 7 different categories for this event.
