I'm always going to stay humble and hungry because I love what I'm doing.




























My name is Fani Peloumpi

events even though I'm 39 years old. Every fight for me is a new















my club in the upcoming national kick boxing tournament. I also volunteer in my local community to keep myself fresh for the games. It is my favorite refreshment.








2022. I also won my 1st world juvenil blue belt last year. Few months back, I won double silver for my school team. I just want to thank my coach and teachers for all the support they provide me.







the time. I just want to keep performing well and keep winning hearts with my performance always.






























My name is Poppy Radke. I am a passionate young adult who loves to express herself during the jitsu matches. The journey so far is not bad. I have won 4
