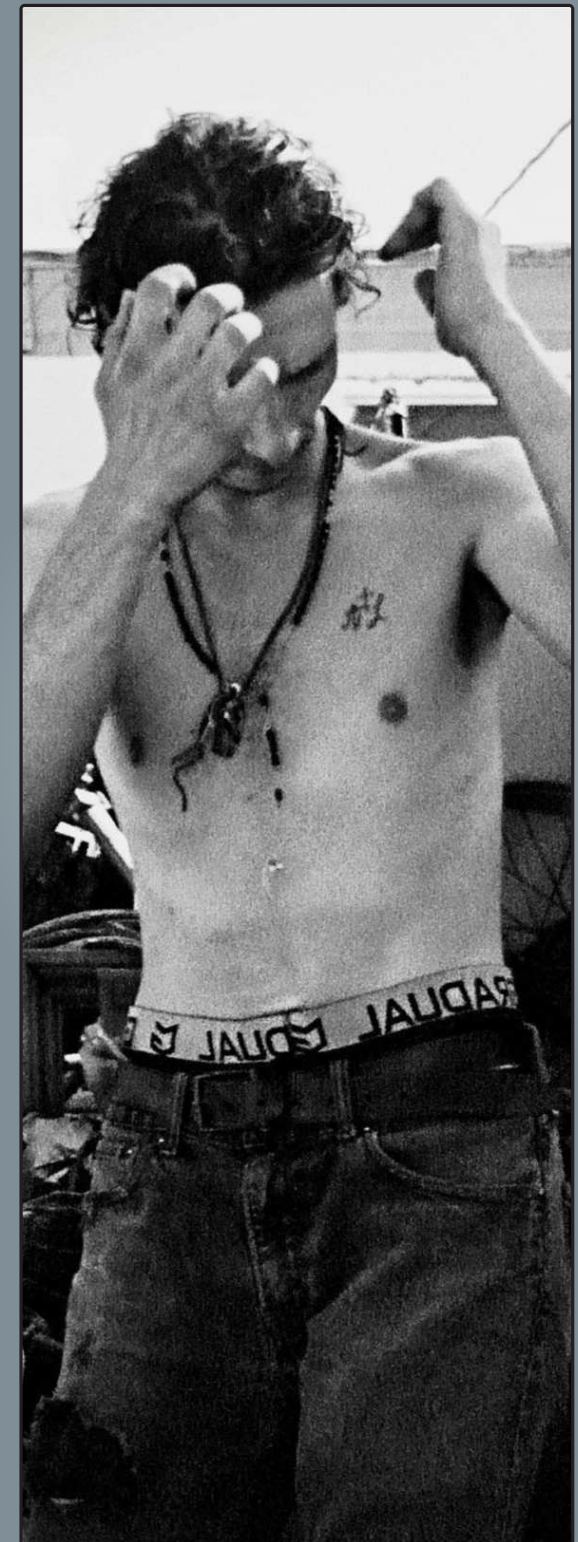
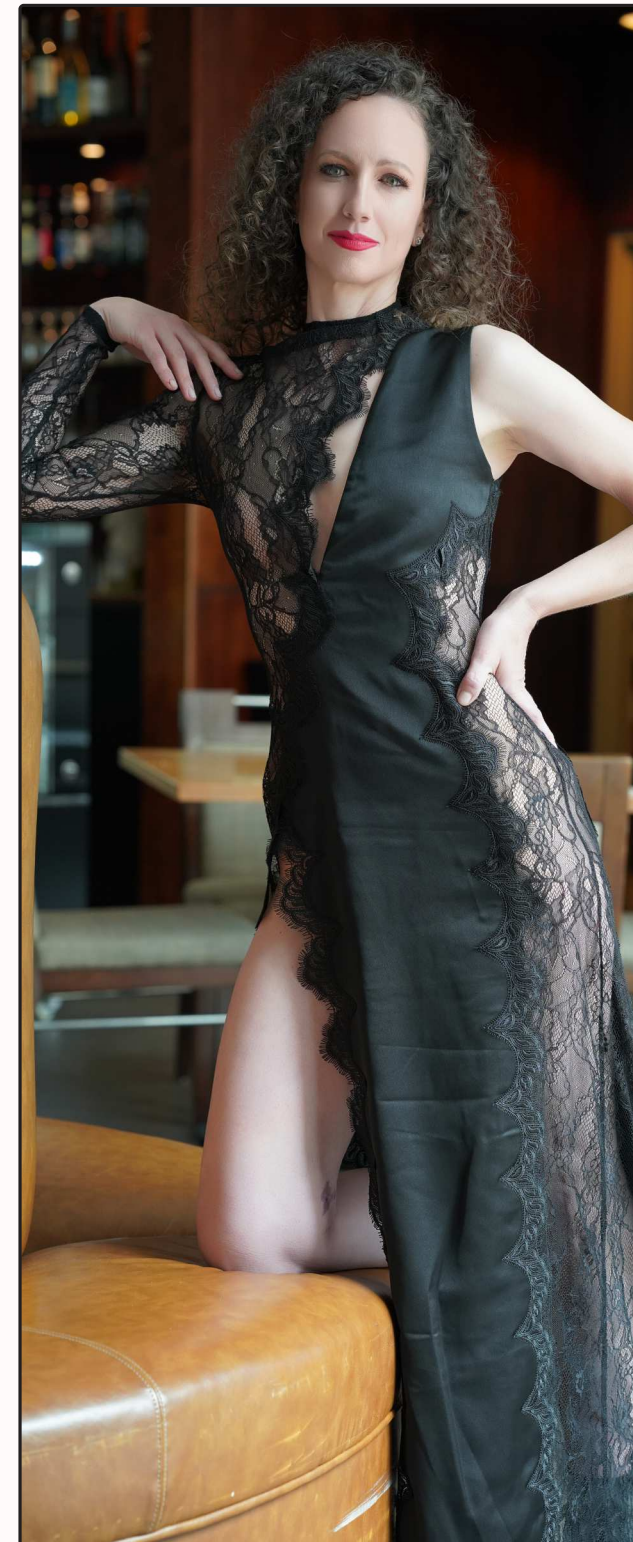

"Peter and the Wolf on Broadway".

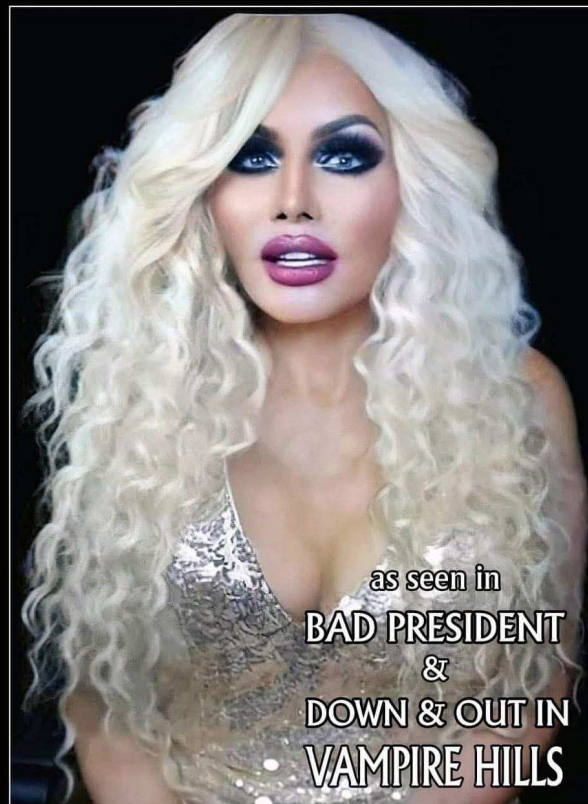

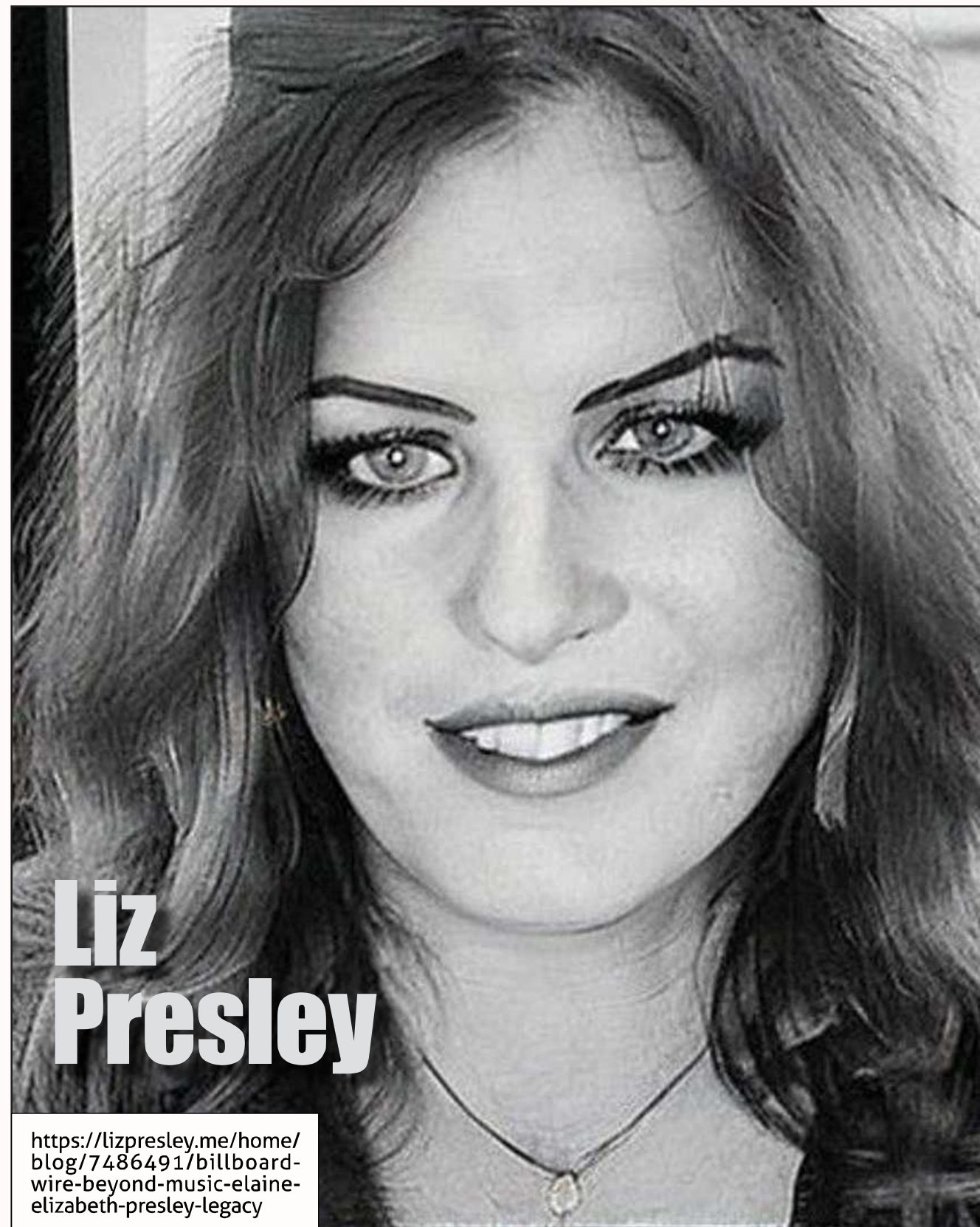
I took some classes in Acting for Film and Television. I have been doing this since 2019 for full time.

Brushstrokes of the Soul: Jordan Lipscomb's Artful Journey in Gunnison, Colorado

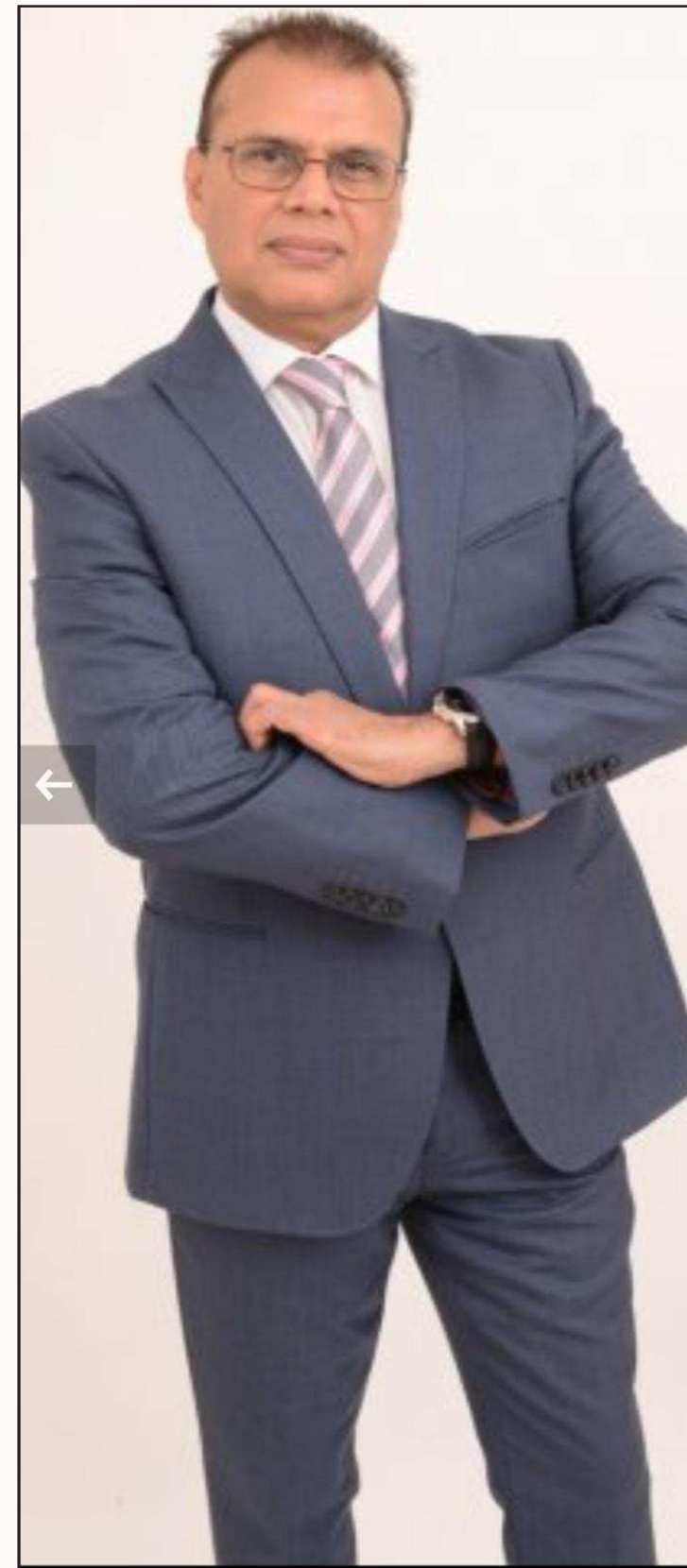
In the heart of the Rocky Mountains, nestled between rolling valleys and open skies, lives an artist whose work reflects not only the breathtaking beauty of Colorado's high country but also the complex emotional landscape of the human experience. Jordan Lipscomb, founder of Jordan Lipscomb Art (JLA) | Vibrant Visions, is a painter, storyteller, and creative force who has turned Gunnison into both a sanctuary and a canvas.

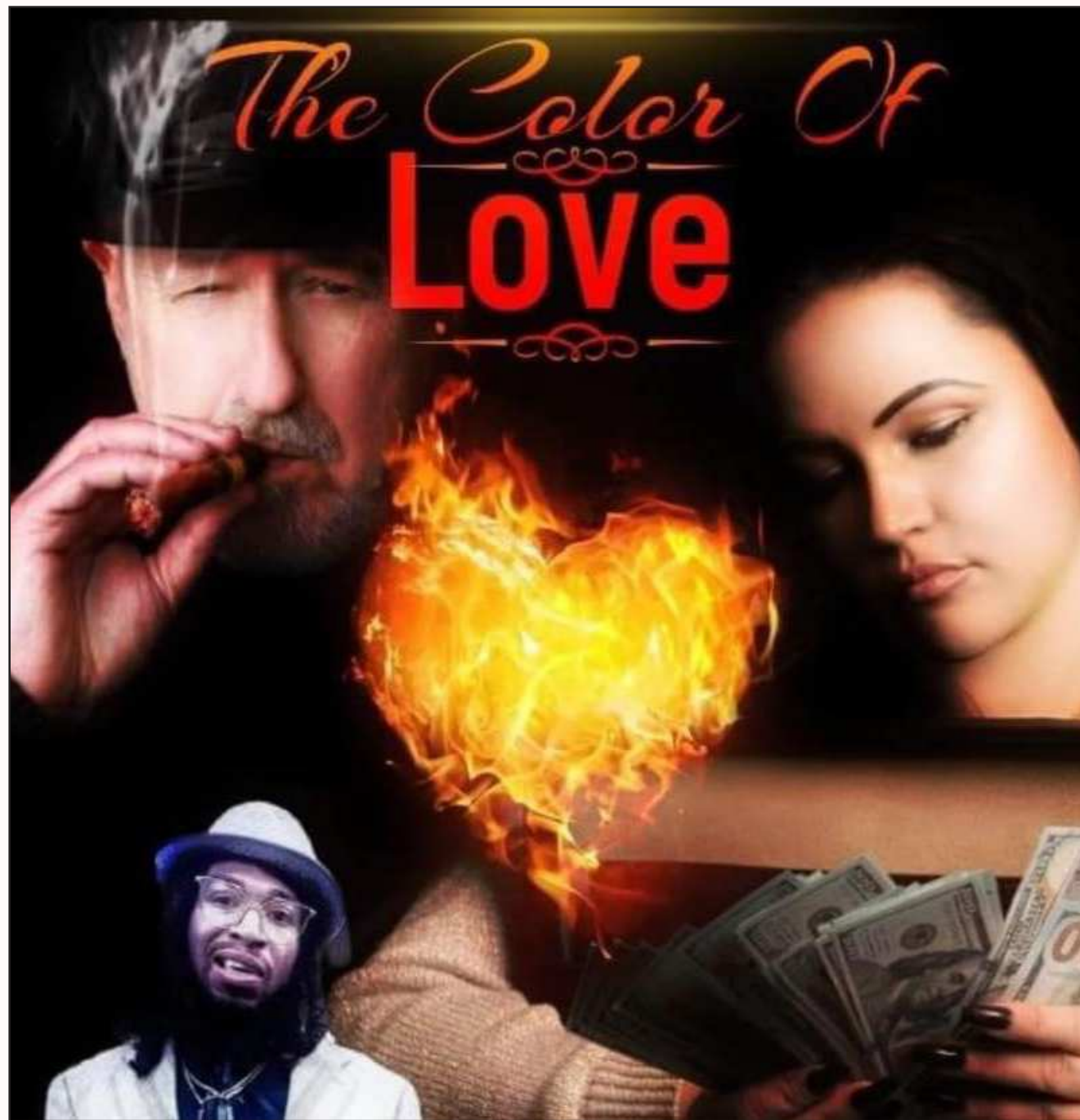
Originally from a more urban setting, Jordan

arrived in Gunnison seeking a quieter life and deeper inspiration. "There's something sacred about the solitude here," Jordan says. "You can hear yourself think, feel every color, and create without the static of the outside world."

Lipscomb's work ranges from vivid acrylic landscapes to abstract emotional pieces, often layered with texture, symbolism, and unexpected color palettes. Each piece tells a story—some personal, some mythological, others inspired by local folklore and the natural rhythms of Colorado's wilderness.

But painting is only part of Jordan's creative

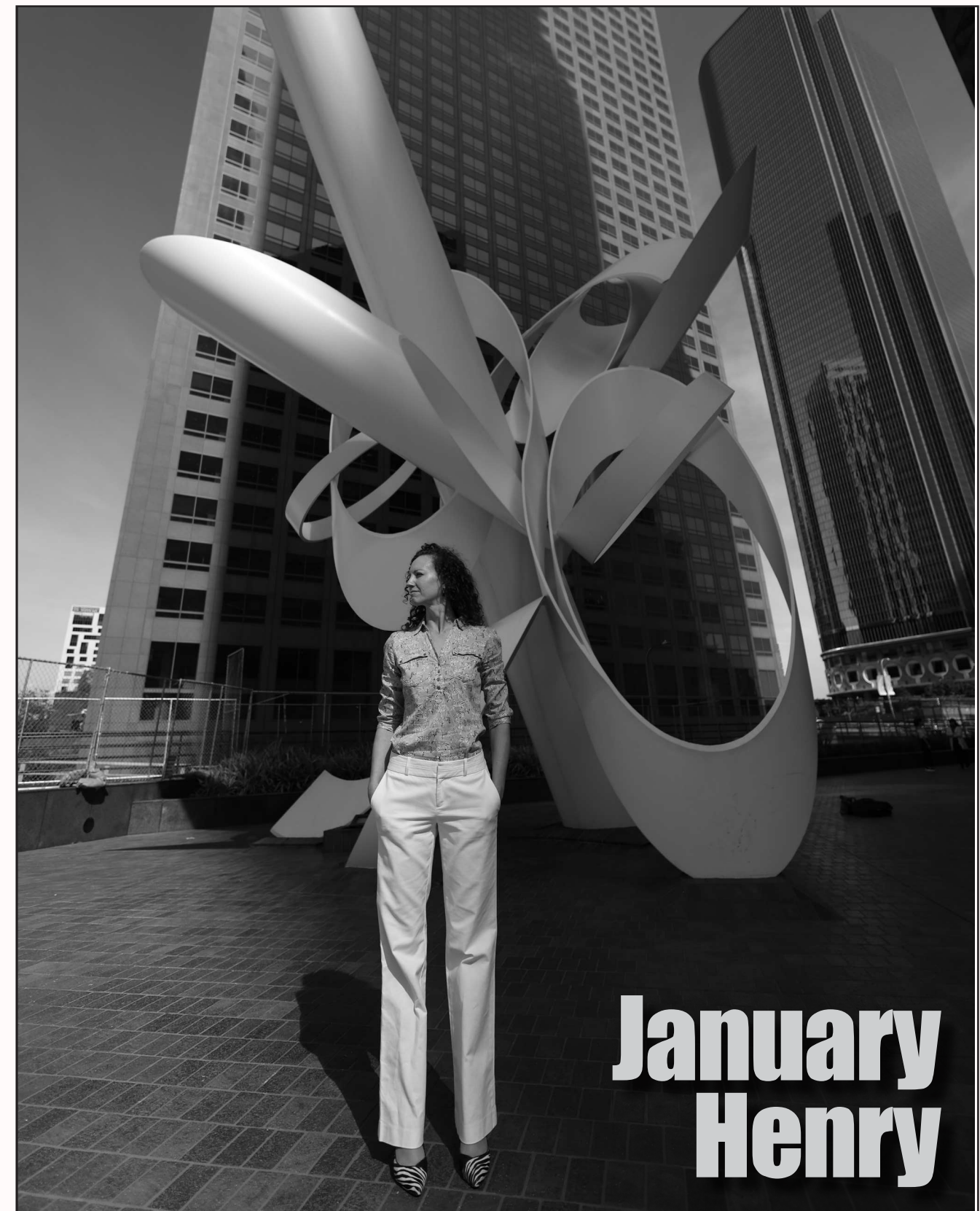

dreams, the path to reaching them wasn't always straightforward.

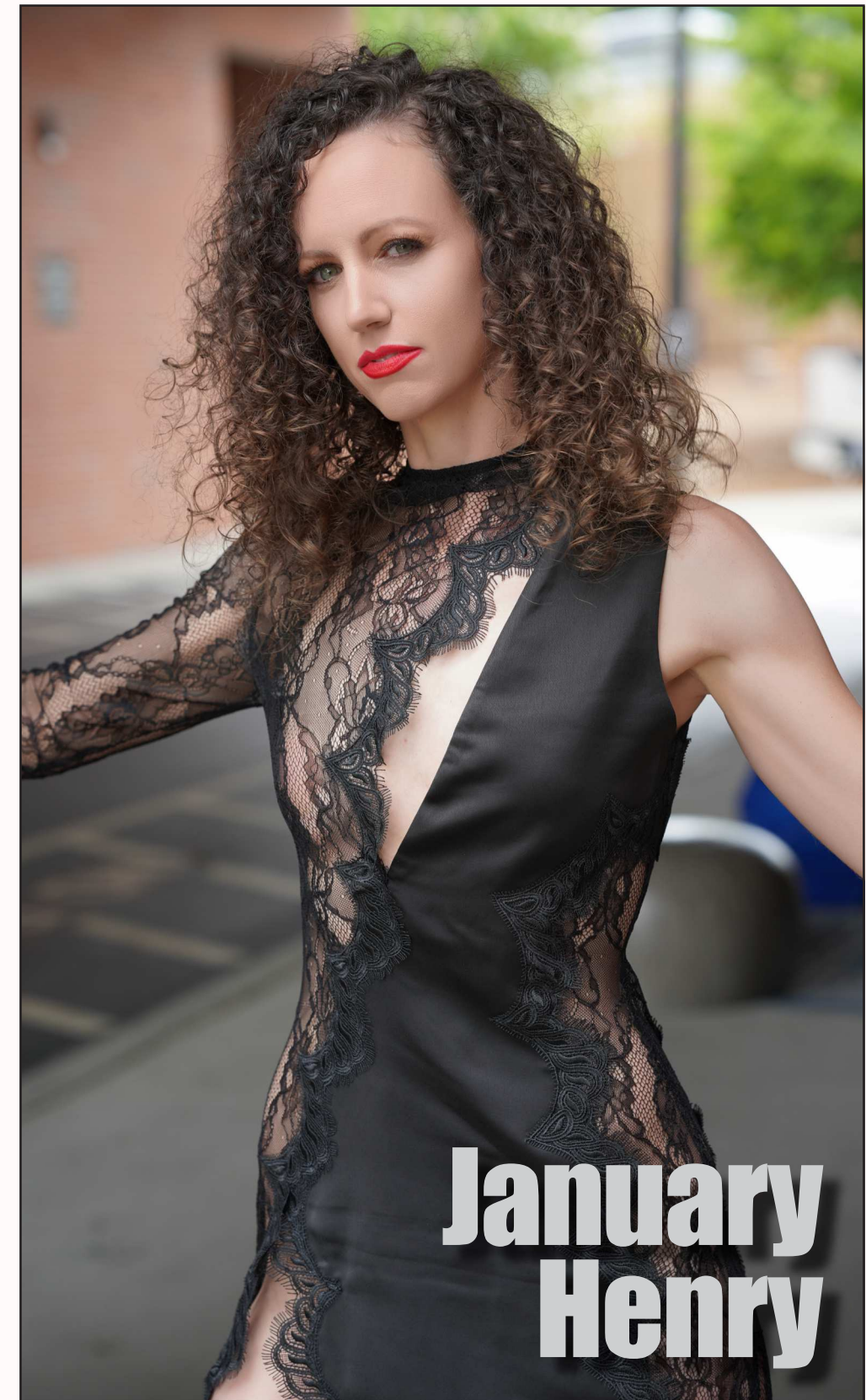
One of my biggest goals has always been to create a life I'm proud of—one built on passion, resilience, and a bit of sparkle. Pursuing modeling and acting
