I've worn many titles: actress, author, spiritual advocate, and cultural contributor. But beyond the accolades and interviews, my greatest achievement is remaining true to myself.


I am the first person in Comic Book history to be a superhero doing what she does in real life between the pages of a comic book.

Hi, I'm Marneen Fields. You may know me as Marneen Lynne Fields for my music—but as Marneen Fields, I've lived a life of daring artistry. A journey that spans acting, stunt work, scriptwriting, filmmaking, and relentless courage. My story is one of dreams pursued, goals realized, achievements earned, and challenges met head-on with grace and grit.

Dreams: Before Hollywood discovered me, I was

a champion college gymnast. That discipline and passion shaped the performer I became. Whether executing high-risk stunts or delivering heartfelt performances, the dream was always to captivate audiences and spark emotion through powerful storytelling.


Goals: My goals have stretched far beyond any one role or genre. I've appeared in over 150 films and primetime TV shows—at every level of

production. I strive to make art that's emotionally raw, narratively bold, and culturally resonant. Each project is a mission: to deepen the conversation and inspire courage through truth.

Achievements: Recognized on Wikipedia as one of the most prominent stuntwomen and stunt actresses of the 1970s and '80s, I've left my mark across Hollywood history. But the accolades didn't stop there. I've won or been nominated for

more than 75 awards celebrating my work in screenwriting, filmmaking, acting, music composition, singing, and stunt performance.

I'm the proud author of the 5-star rated book "The Illusive Craft of Acting: An Actor's Preparation Process," offering aspiring artists a blueprint for authenticity. My award-winning short documentary "The Remarkable Resilience of Marneen Fields" showcases my incredible journey. My film, "Marie: Who's Gonna Take Care



of Me," tells the story of saving my mentally ill and homeless mother—a deeply personal and socially vital narrative. And coming Spring 2026, my filmography book "Rolling with the Punches with a Hollywood Fall Girl" will chronicle it all.

In June this year I was booked as a celebrity at the famous Hollywood Show for my role of Dorothy (Scarecrow's girlfriend at the Oz Network) on the hit TV series, "Scarecrow and Mrs. King."

I've just released a new single titled It's Not the End of the World You Don't Love Me, available now on all major platforms—a soulful anthem of heartbreak and empowerment.

Challenges: Through it all, I've battled enormous challenges. A near-fatal car accident led to a series of life-threatening operations. My severe hearing impairment and ongoing physical limitations—residual effects of my stunt career—have tested me in every way imaginable. But pain sharpened my artistry. Limitations forged deeper layers in my performance. The obstacles haven't kept me down—they've made me unshakable.

I remain fiercely devoted to the arts, to the mission, and to the message: resilience is the true mark of greatness.

A Final Message to Fellow Artists To every artist out there chasing a dream that others might not




understand—keep chasing it anyway. Your vision matters. Your voice matters. And the courage to create, even when you're broken or battling uphill, is the most profound performance of all.






