Florence "Flo-Jo" Joyner 1952-1998

Born on December 21, 1952, in Union City, and Florence Diana Joyner, Florence became Joyner upon her marriage to her first husband, who was the coach of the Florida State University track and field team.

After a college at Florida, Florence became interested in the athletic field and went to the University of Florida. Working for her father, she was the first woman to be named All-American in the 100 and 200 meters and the 4x100 relay. She was also named All-American in the 100 and 200 meters and the 4x100 relay. 

Thanks to her exceptional athletic ability, Joyner's name is forever etched in the history of sports. She is remembered for her speed, her determination, and her ability to overcome adversity.




