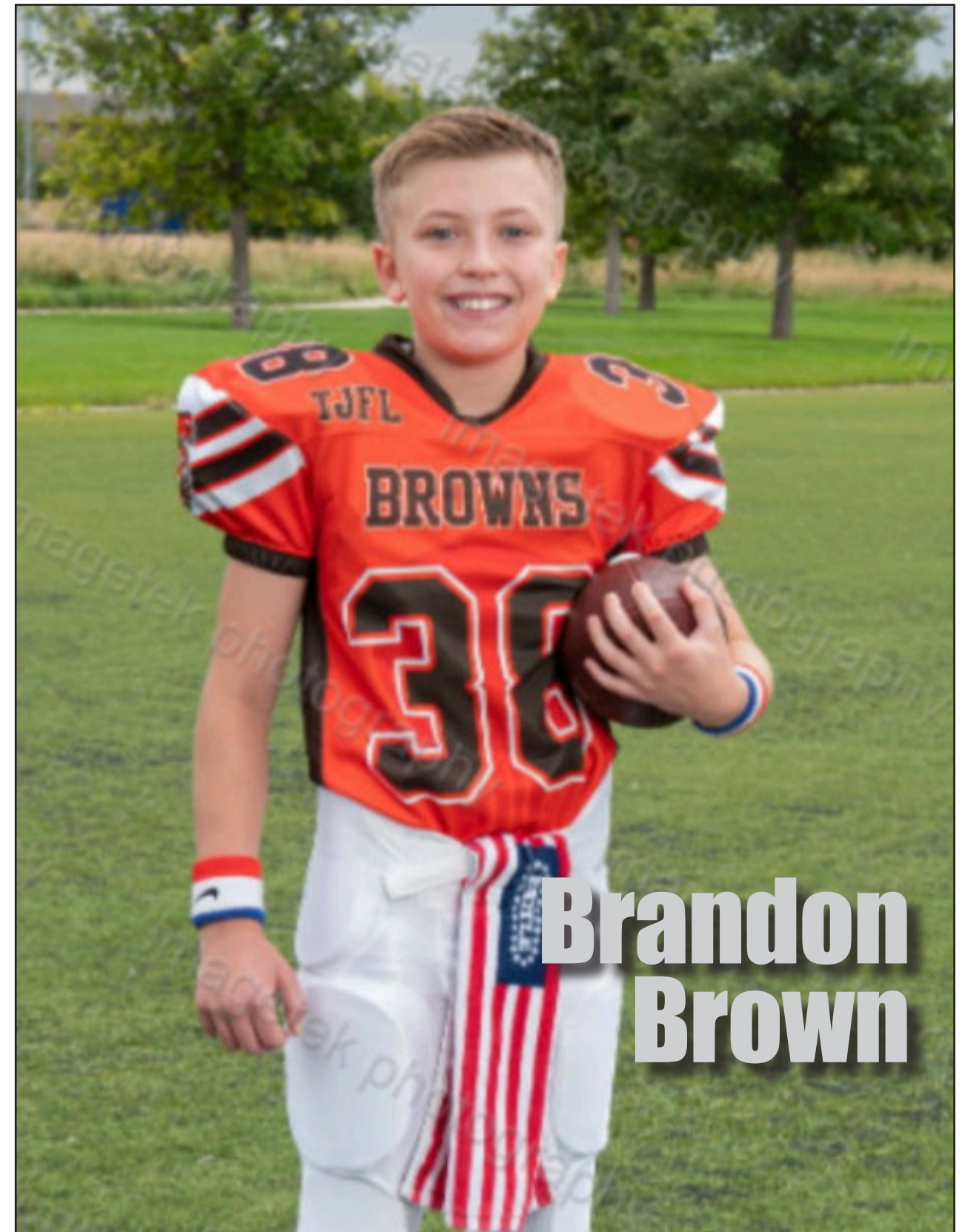

I will be on America's Got Talent Season 20.

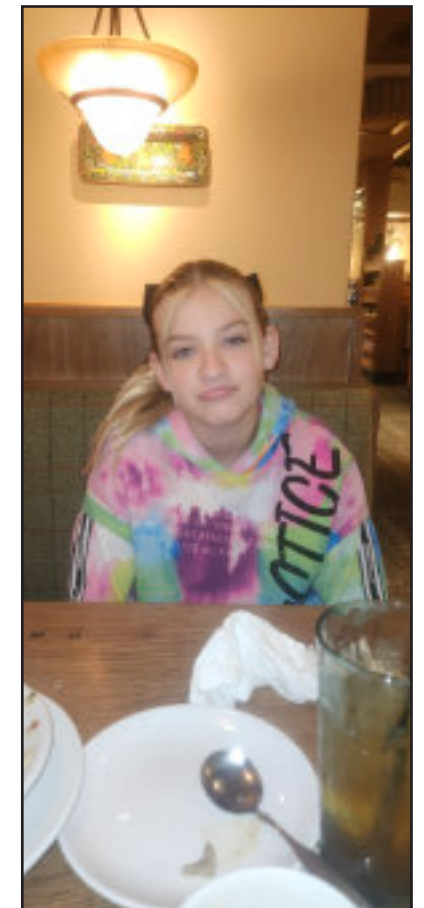
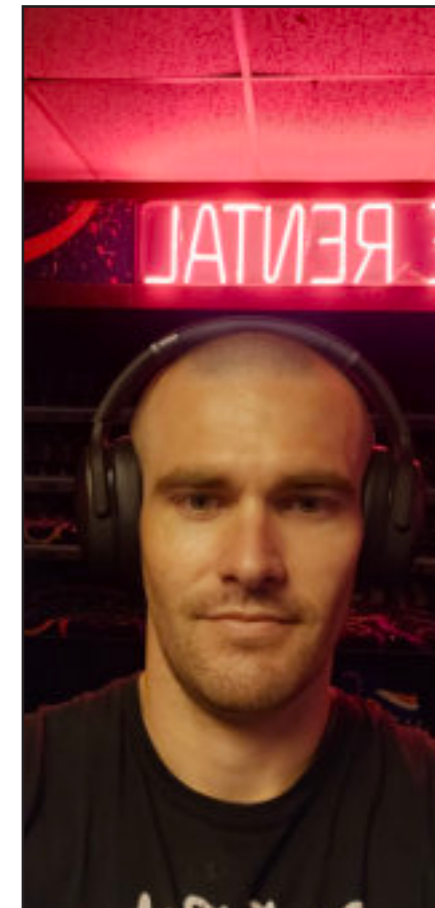
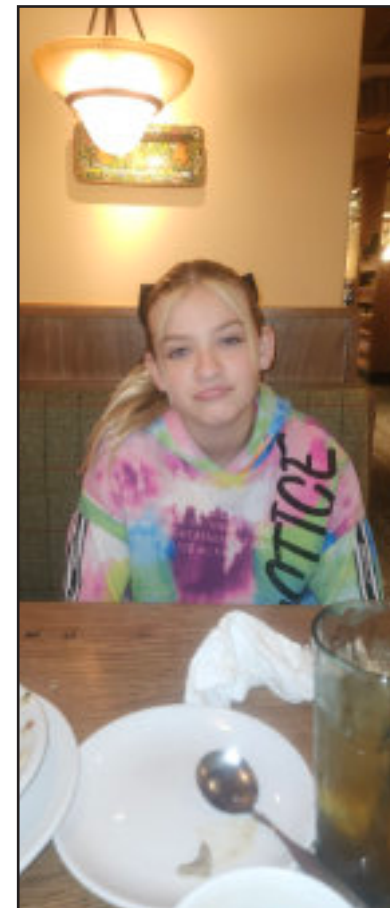
