From a young age I discovered my passion for figure skating and it quickly became a significant part of my life. I first got on the ice when I was just a toddler at 4 years old. I would practice at public sessions working my way up levels and soon began taking learn to skate USA classes at my local rink. After passing all of the levels I moved on to skating by myself at freestyle sessions and taking private lessons. Later on, I began taking moves in the field tests for US figure skating as well as testing for freestyle levels. Currently I am working on testing Pre-Gold moves in the field and Pre-Silver Freestyle. One of my biggest goals is to pass all of the Moves in the Field and Freestyle tests for US figure skating and become a double gold medalist.

Competing is one of my favorite things to do with my TOI (theater on ice) team. This is my fourth year competing in theater on ice.

Adding onto TOI I also compete individually for excel series and this year I will be competing for showcase. I also perform in shows such as the nutcracker on ice and skating through movies, etc, at my local rink.

My biggest achievement so far in skating would be either passing silver moves in the field or getting first place at theater on ice competition with my team. Although after winning the TOI nationals qualifying competition with my team, I experienced a stress fracture on a growth plate. I couldn't compete at the 2024 national TOI competition and I had to watch my team compete without me. This was by far my biggest challenge because all that I worked for was wasted on an injury. But after doing physical therapy for months I am almost fully recovered and looking forward to competing at the 2025 national theater on ice competition in Texas!

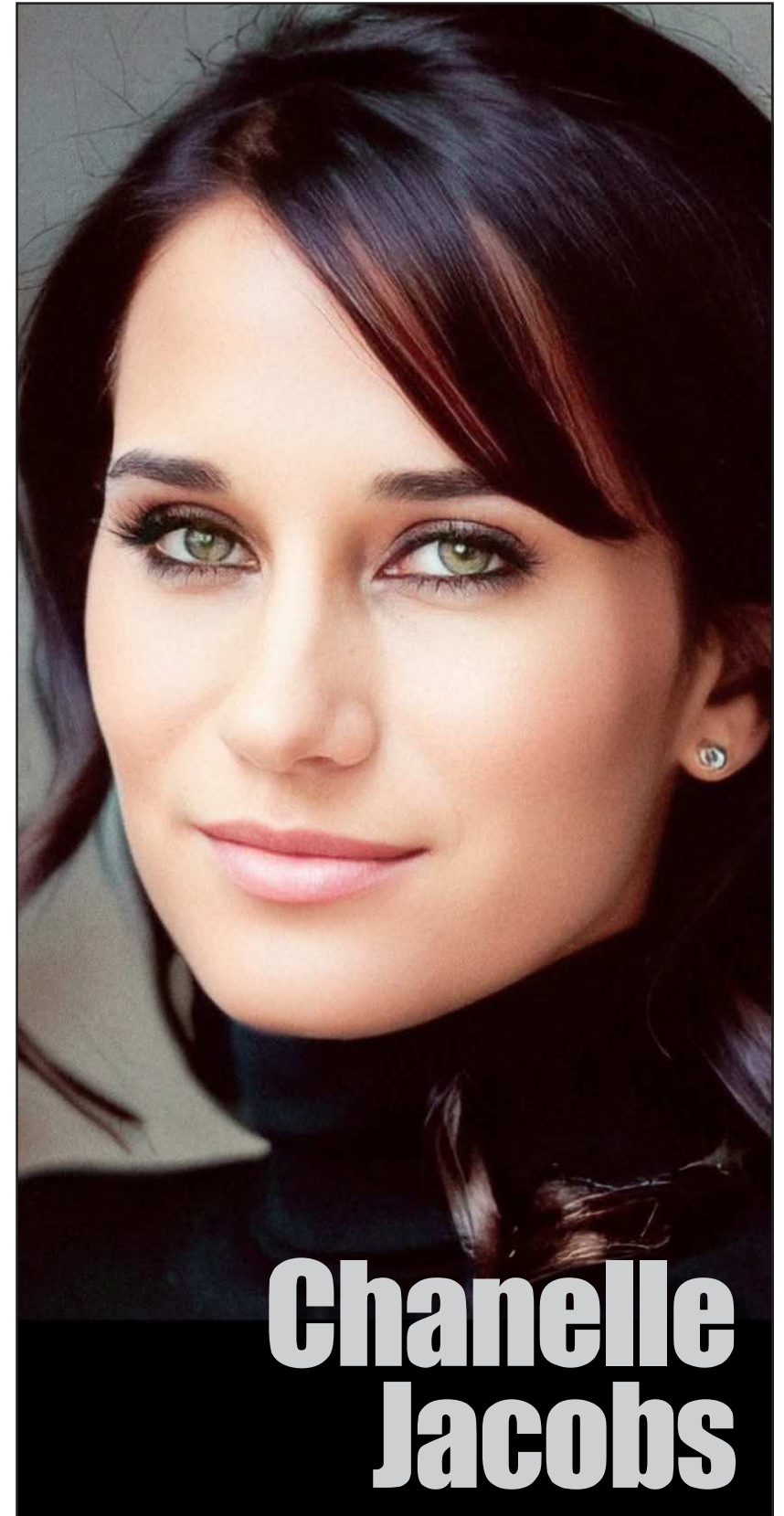

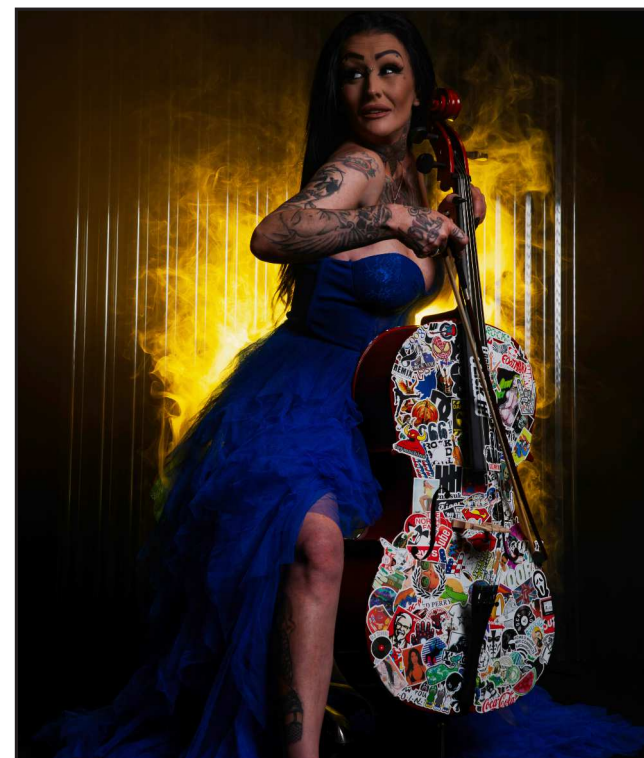
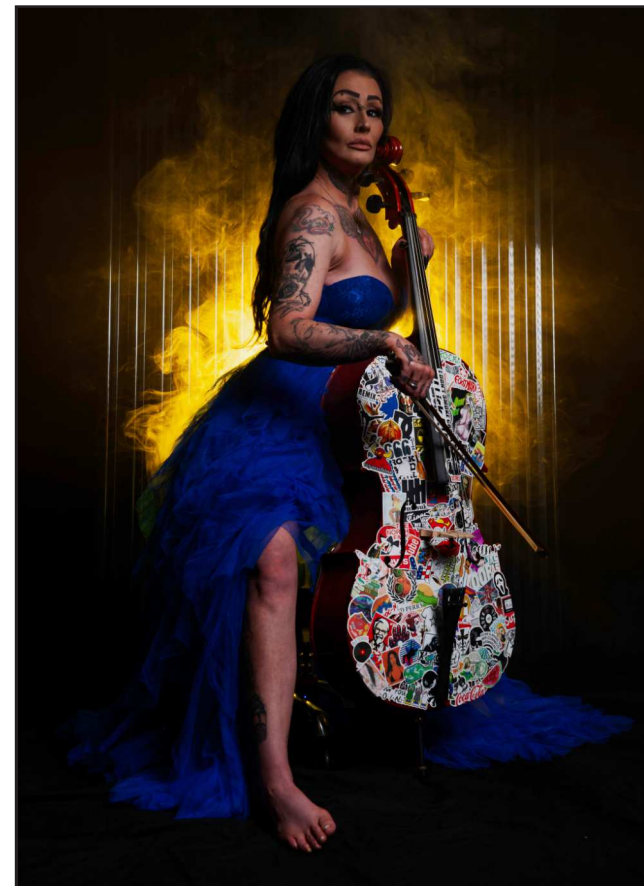

I'm represented by Gray Talent Group in Chicago and managed by my mom, MicheleHefner. You can connect with me on Instagram, X and Facebook. You can





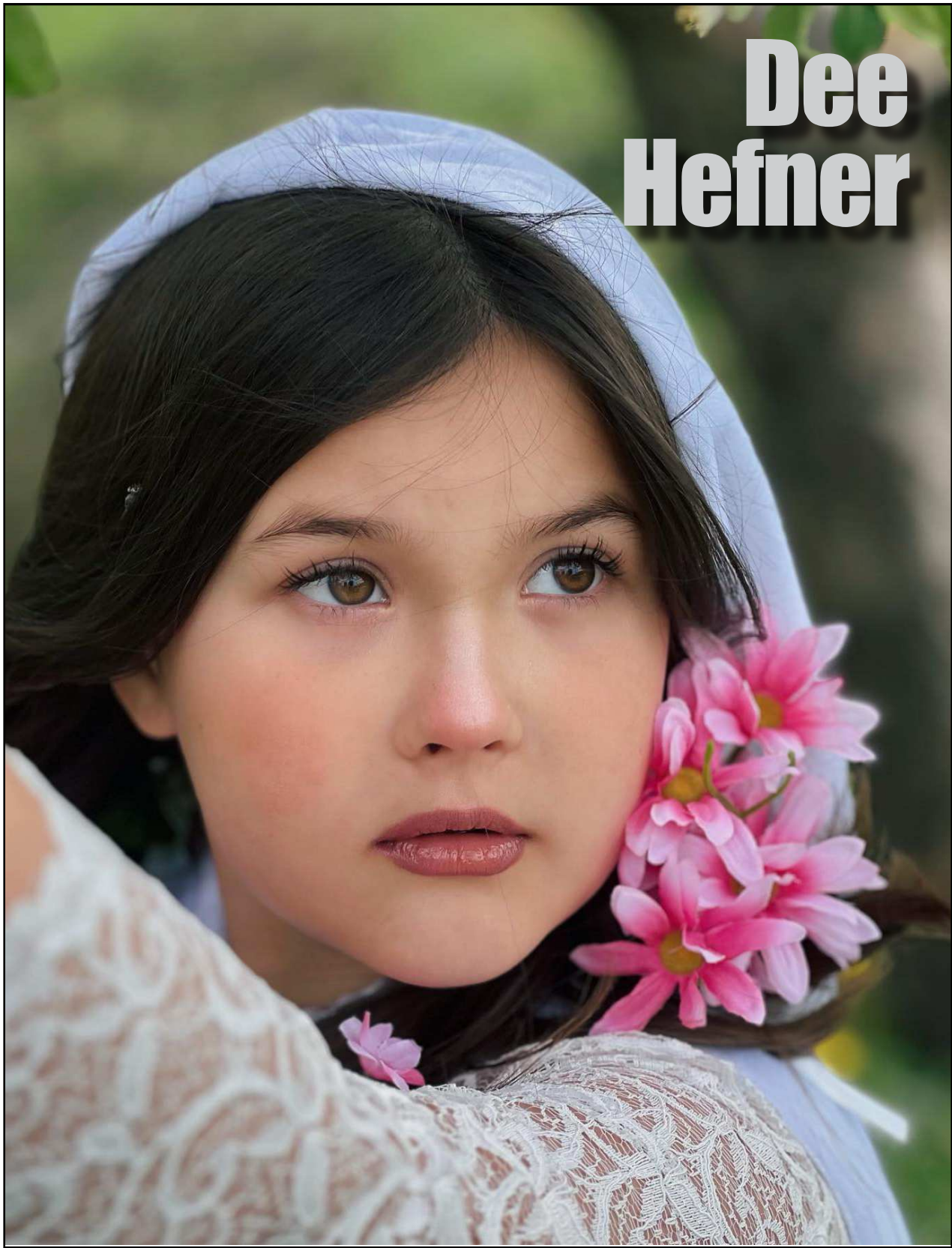

9) What I learned about myself during this experience is that I dont give up on what I really want to do in life, and that you can prove everyone wrong in life.

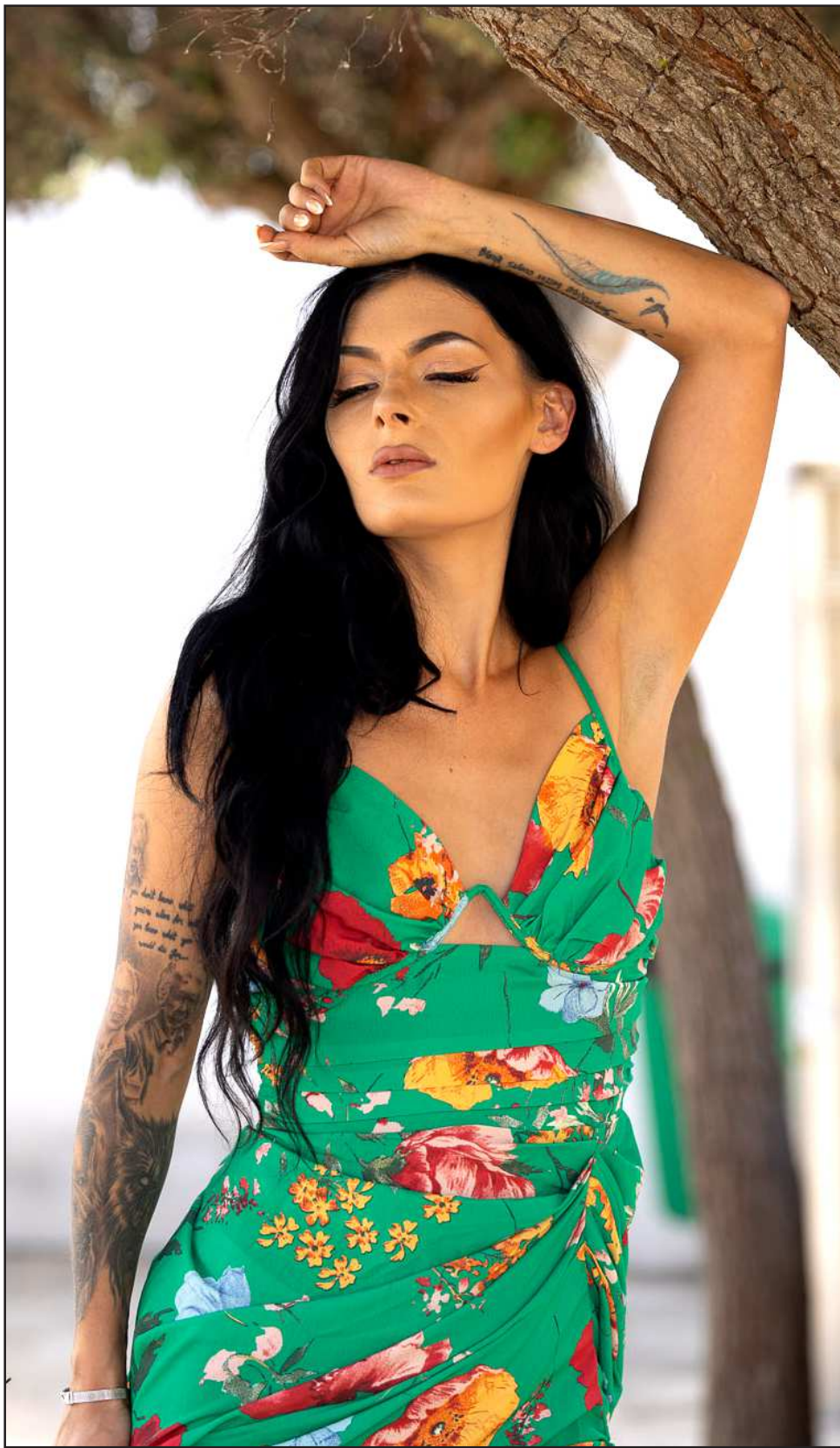
10) I think that the time we put into such a huge yearly pageant makes it very special. And that I could have participated in this pageant makes it even more special to me.
