




















Dancing Through Dreams: My Journey as a Professional Dancer




Her ultimate dream? To be accepted to dance at the University of Minnesota and compete at the D1 level.




dancer is a success for everyone. Dance is what gives me my strength and energy. No matter the challenges, dance is always there for me, and I would not trade it for anything.
