My Agent Jenny became my mentor, I was very blessed to be put forwards for many castings and was chosen to Model for Kays, Littlewoods Catalogue, MB Games, Kendal's Christmas Charity Campaign, BBC News round did a story on us, and many other castings! I loved Modelling, Acting, Singing/Dance and would often get involved in Drama at School and casted for Acting roles, joined the School Choir, and a Dance school! I often would Model Julia's gowns, which also helped me get a few castings one of them in "Jack The Ripper Tours" Promo for my friend Jenny Philips, who is often seen in White Chapel telling the story of Jack the Ripper and walking around the streets he once did! I love Musical Theatre to and doing "Panto" and recently played to role of "Wishy Washy" in "Alladin" for "Broadstone Pantomime Productions" in Dorset as a friend runs the Theatre company, we all had so much fun! 


for release on Father's Day 2025.



Runway modeling holds a special place in my heart. The energy is electric, and representing a




