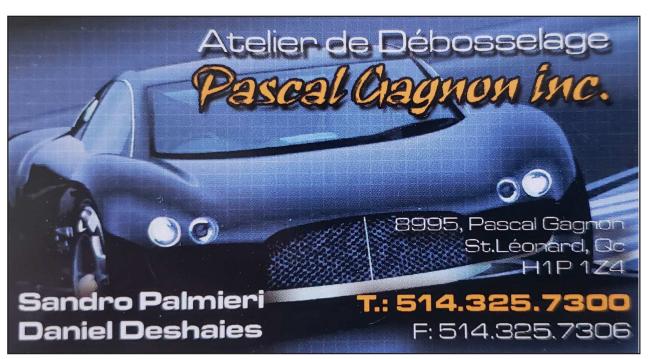


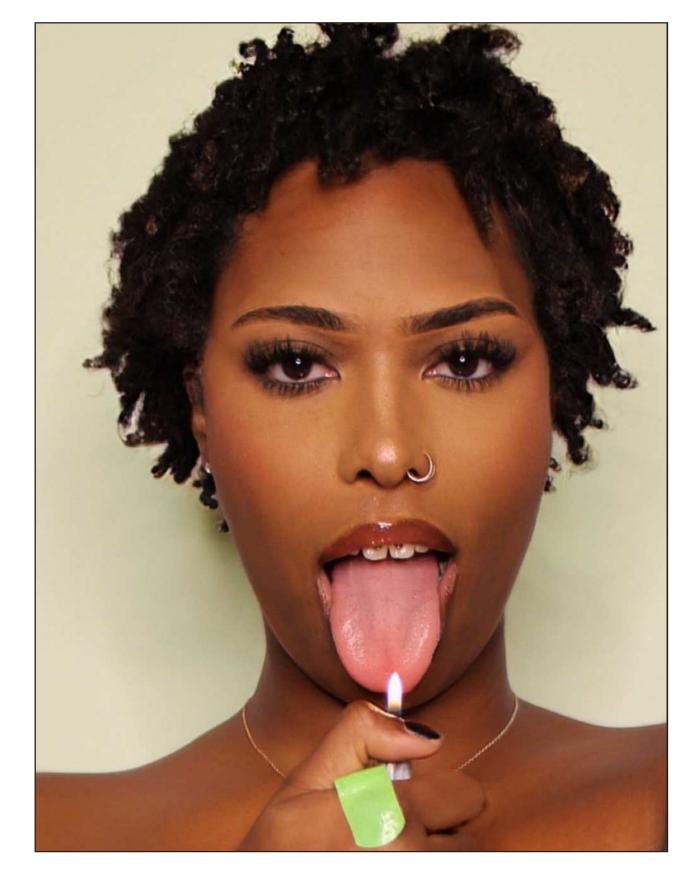




















I am a mother of six, a woman with a natural body, and a soul who has never stopped dreaming — not even when the world told me I should.

My dream is to grace the pages of a bikini magazine as a reminder that:

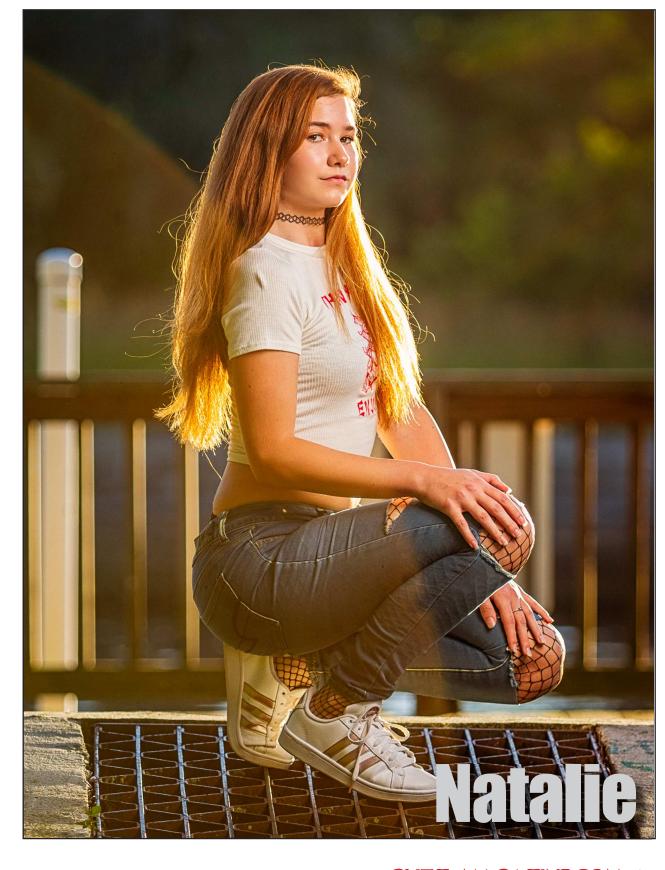
- Motherhood isn't the end of beauty — it's the beginning of a new kind.

In June this year I was booked as a celebrity at the famous Hollywood Show for my role of





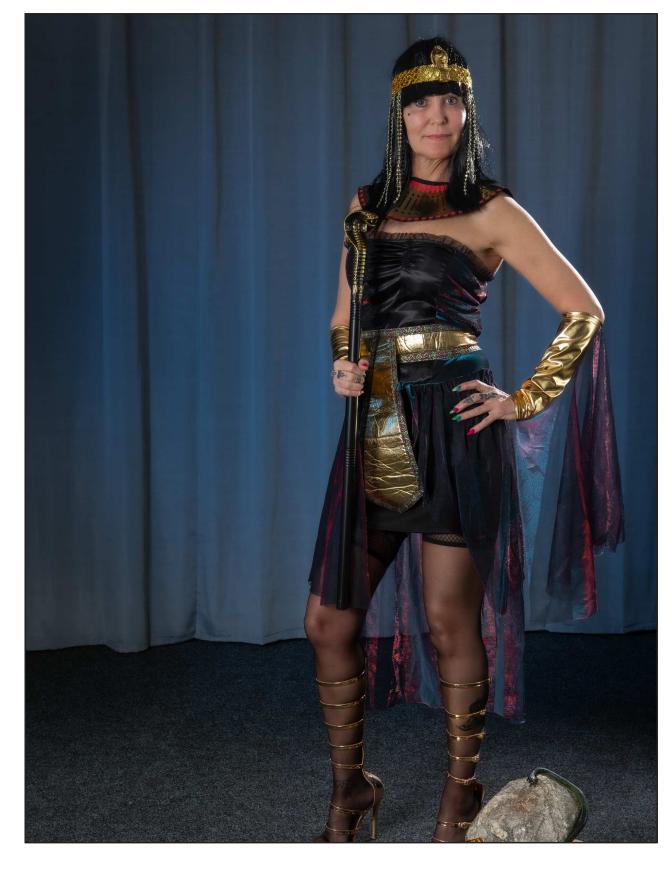
