


My name is Angelica. I am a gymnastics and gradually I am getting things done. Actually now, little by little, i started


getting along with summary weather and different schedule. I liked it during winter , I love it now, and I am sure I'll enjoy it in






The thing that really matters to me is that, if I asked my little self, that has been doing her first step in ballet, if she is proud of who I am now, what would she say.

future nor did I have any worries about it. I really don't understand that the little girl who was so sure about the bright future waiting for her.








Kayla Davies

understood completely different after finishing our academy and it my sound scary but it is really inspiring at the same time.







continue, I need to face these challenges. I want to continue this using the same energy and motivation I have now. Being on the balancing beam is always exciting.


