




Danielle Deal



Heather Fawcett





My name is Heather Fawcett. I just won a gold medal in the regional championship. It is such a pleasure to share with you all. My hard work brought results. I

The only American to coach a male gymnast to Olympic All-Around Gold (Paul Hamm, 2004). He supports and coaches me to be the best gymnast I can be! We work out/train 3 days a week, 4 hours a day. I'm grateful to be at OSEGA with the best coaches and teammates a girl could ask for. I'm going to keep working hard to achieve my dream of becoming an Olympic Gold Medalist. I live, sleep, eat and breathe gymnastics. I'm eight years old and I'm the youngest and smallest on our team. At State Competition, I took first place on beam, 2nd on bars, 3rd on floor and 4th on vault. I was second all around 38.25. At Regionals I got my first perfect ten on uneven bars and also became the Vault and Uneven Bars regional champion. My All-Around score was 38.6, and I made the Regional Team. Also, I competed in New Orleans at Nationals and became the National Beam Champion. I placed 3rd AA and had an all around score of 38.8. I was chosen to train at the NGA National Training Camp this year. One of the harder skills for me to learn was a kip. It took me a few months to understand the timing and when to rotate my wrists. After countless hours in the gym, I finally perfected it! I'm excited to continue my gymnastics journey & learn more skills every day. Gymnastics is such a huge part of my life, and I won't quit until I reach my dreams.






My name is Leah Ann. I just regularly train and follow whatever my heart says and finally achieve great end to regular things. I am currently training for States championship. I am also happy to






A few years ago I discovered a sport that is my passion, it is the rhythmic gymnastics. Thanks to my professional academy I have




been falling in love with it every day.
