therefore constantly propelling my craft and desire to be better than I was the day before. As I travel farther out, meet even more inspiring artists, and continue to grow not just as an artist


but as a person as well, I can see my art progress further and further in ways it never would have were I in the stagnant jobs I've held in the past.














I started my journey into body piercing about 1995

I studied every bit of information I can get my hands on for the next couple years

than did a year long apprenticeship and from there opened my first studio

it was no easy task getting all of my information and training together, let alone in one place

It was pretty clear to me when i performed my first piercing that i would teach others to do this

As I was always been kind of ago to guy amongst my peers it was just a natural progression

Where it practiced in Massachusetts there was a lot of resistance to body art

In fact tattooing was banned so in the early days of my business i was piercing only


Ultimately the ban was lifted, but the city i practiced in malden MA along with other cities tried to use prohibitive zoning to keep people from practicing

So of course I sued the city and handed there ass to them as this prohibitive zoning was a constitutional violation

As Body art is a protected form of free speech

However this action turner out to be a double edged sword as I had paved the way for solid practitioners to practice there passion and do the right thing

I also paved the way for knuckleheads to do the wrong thing



At this point it became painfully obvious that was time to write my course and offer this training

As these knuckleheads were a serious threat to public safety

So in the interest of public safety i started offering my training around 2003

Additionally when it think back of how difficult it was for me to acquire my education and training

I've really wanted to make this available for a viable candidates to get all their education and training and one place

You notice and mention viable candidates, I hand pick every student i accept

There is a phone interview process with each candidate at which point if me and the candidate decide this is a good fit i provide a password and they may submit there registration

as this training offering is my personal mission the get more solid candidates out there doing this


and i am happy to report that after 20 years or so of offering this training

you're all beautiful in your own way! You're all strong and are never alone!


