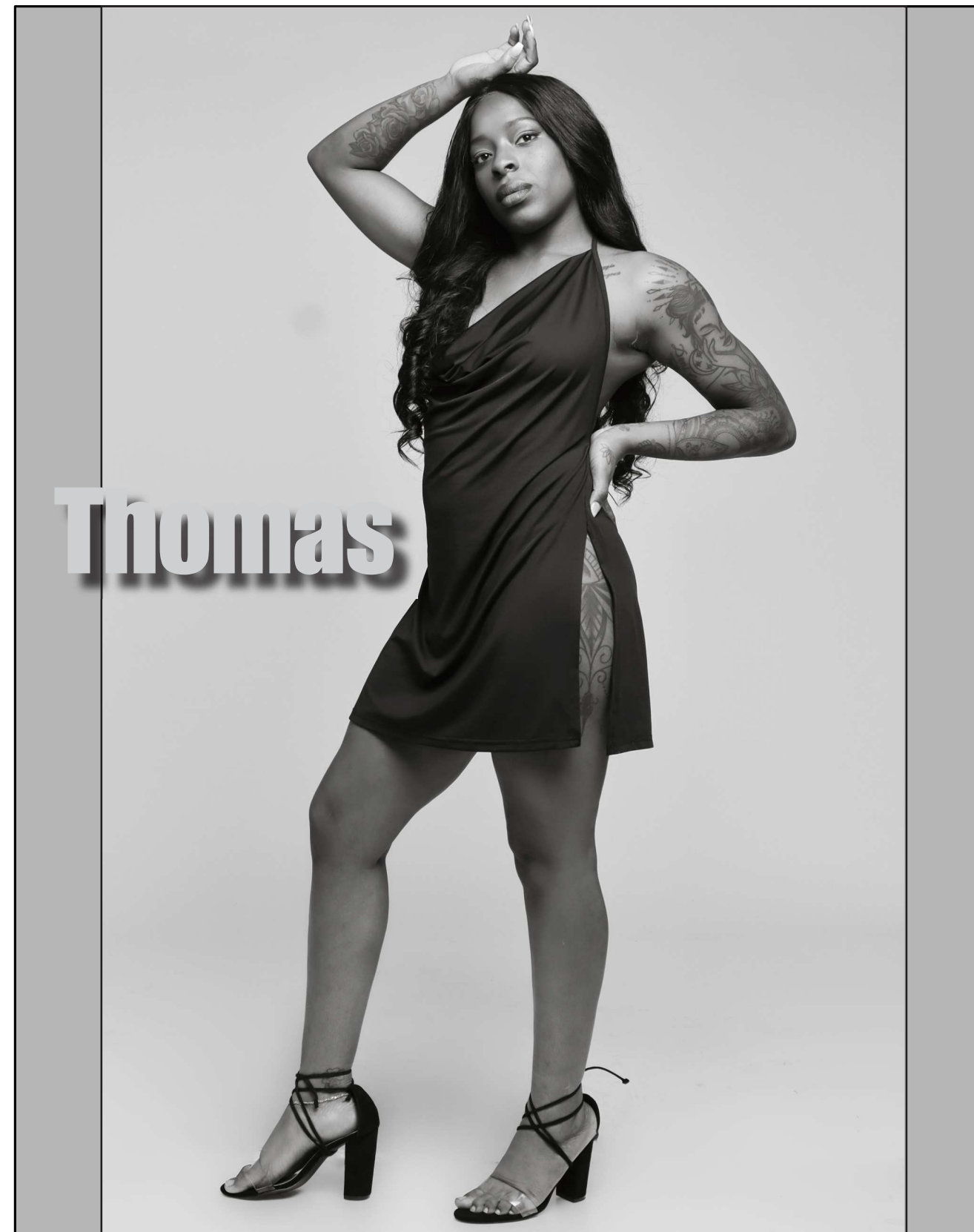




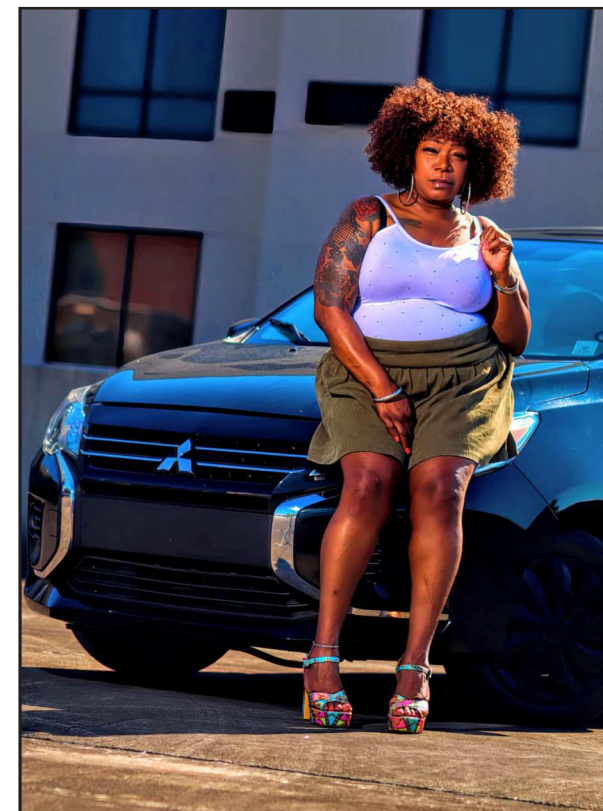

Bryant O'Donnell: Transforming Trials into Triumph for a World Without AIDS

In the heart of a small, rural town, where resources were scarce and inclusive education even scarcer, Bryant O'Donnell forged his own path to become a beacon of hope, resilience, and unapologetic authenticity. A proud activist, influencer, entertainer, host, and promoter, Bryant's journey is a testament to turning life's challenges into a powerful force for change. His story, brimming with courage and purpose, is one that inspires and uplifts, making him a true luminary in the fight for HIV awareness and LGBTQ+ advocacy.

Growing up in the 1990s, Bryant faced a world where being part of the LGBTQ+ community was rarely discussed openly, especially within his

own family. Without role models to guide him or access to comprehensive education about HIV, he navigated his identity and life lessons through sheer determination. "I had to create my own persona," Bryant shares, reflecting on his journey of self-discovery. At 23, he came out, embarking on a decade-long relationship that culminated in a six-year marriage. Though the marriage ended in divorce, Bryant views this moment not as a setback but as the spark that ignited his true self. "It was the start of stepping into who I truly was," he says with conviction.

Just one week after his divorce, Bryant faced another life-altering moment: an HIV-positive diagnosis on October 27, 2021. What could have been a devastating blow became the cornerstone of his life's mission. "I turned what was supposed to take me out into my guiding light," he declares.

Today, Bryant is a passionate spokesmodel for HIV Stops with Me, one of New York State's

largest and longest-running HIV campaigns. As a New York State Certified Peer Worker in HIV and Harm Reduction, and a graduate with an Associate of Applied Science in Community & Human Services, he has transformed his personal struggles into a platform for advocacy and education. Bryant's motto, "Turning My Mess into a Message & My Vulnerability into a Superpower,"

encapsulates his dynamic work as a motivational speaker and "edutainer." As the Founder, Director, and CEO of RaisingA The VIBRATION, he channels his energy into uplifting communities, breaking stigma, and fostering hope. His previous roles as a Ryan White Case Manager at the Southern Tier AIDS Program, Inc., and Director of Recreation at Norwich Rehabilitation and Nursing Center showcase his commitment to



service. "I speak out, not for myself, but to be a voice for those who've had theirs taken from them," he says, his words resonating with purpose.

As an LGBTQ+ activist, Bryant is relentless in his dedication to HIV prevention and awareness. His mission is clear: to end the stigma surrounding HIV, break the cycle of silence, and celebrate a future free from AIDS. With every speech, every campaign, and every heartfelt connection, Bryant O'Donnell is not just raising the vibration—he's rewriting the narrative, proving that vulnerability is indeed a superpower. 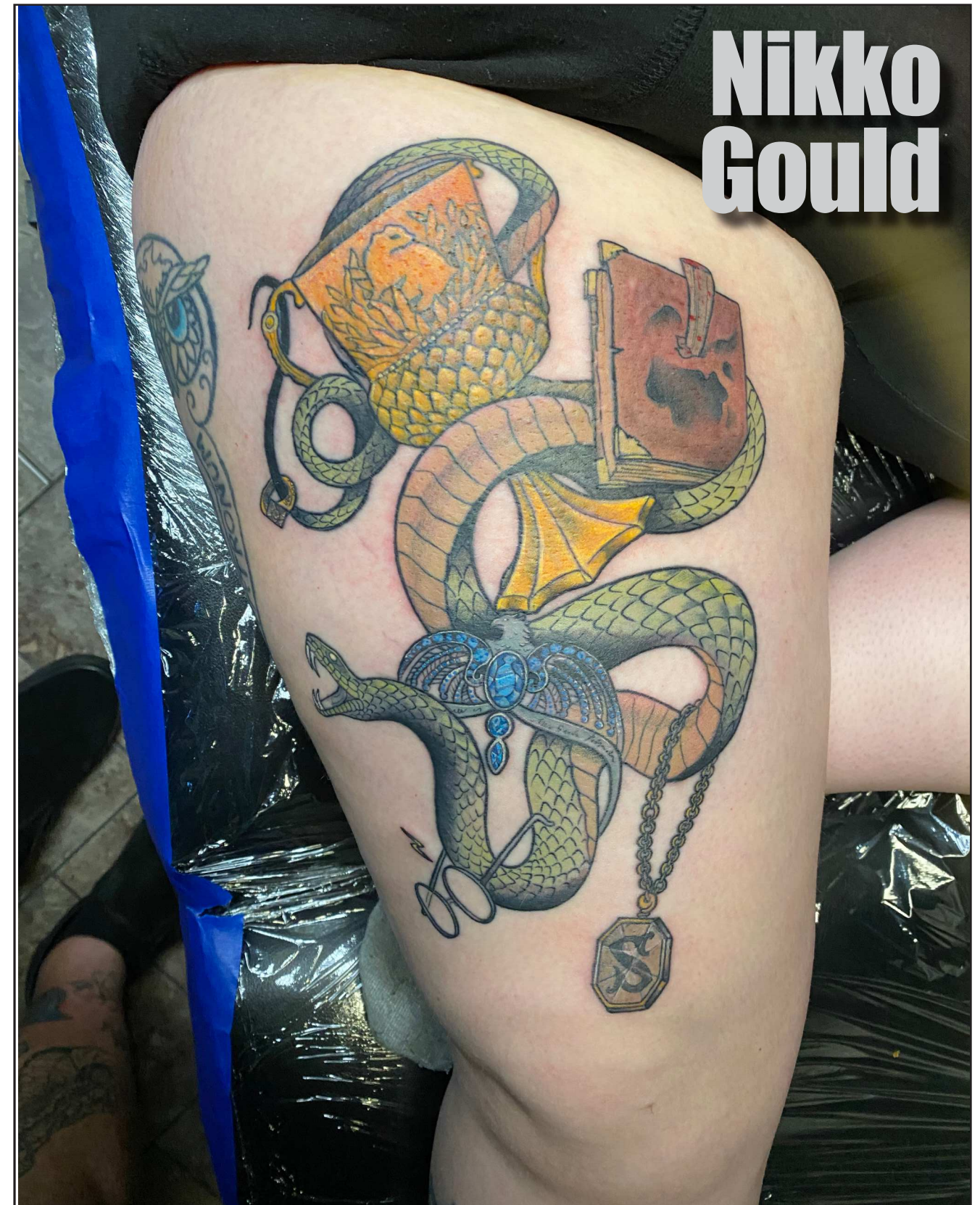
I have been lucky enough that through tattooing I have Managed to achieve most of goals in life, I have worked around the world, had my work published in magazines and books, I have won

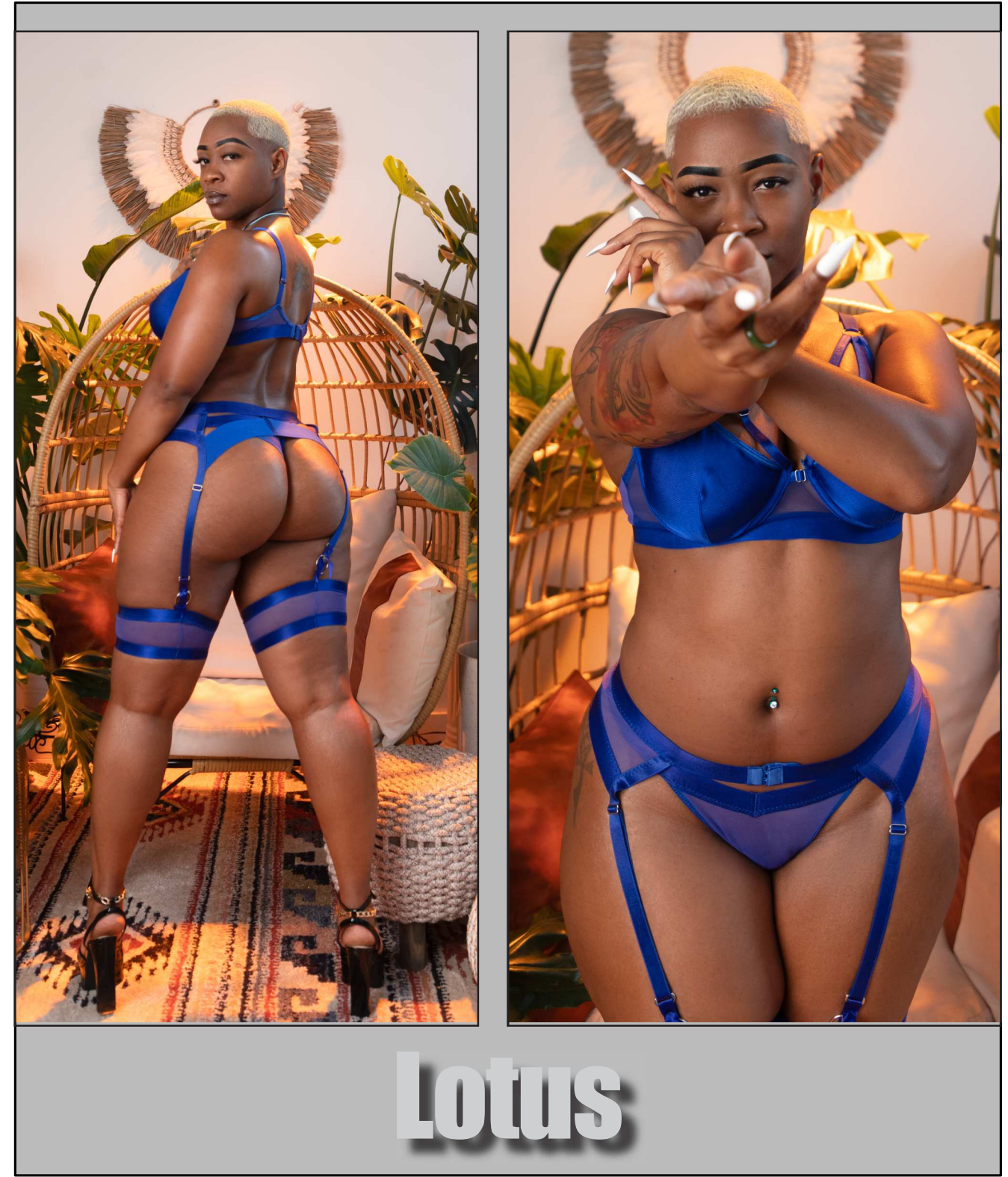
