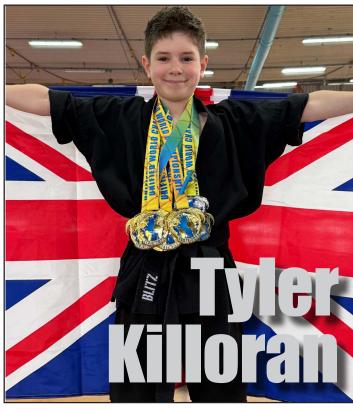

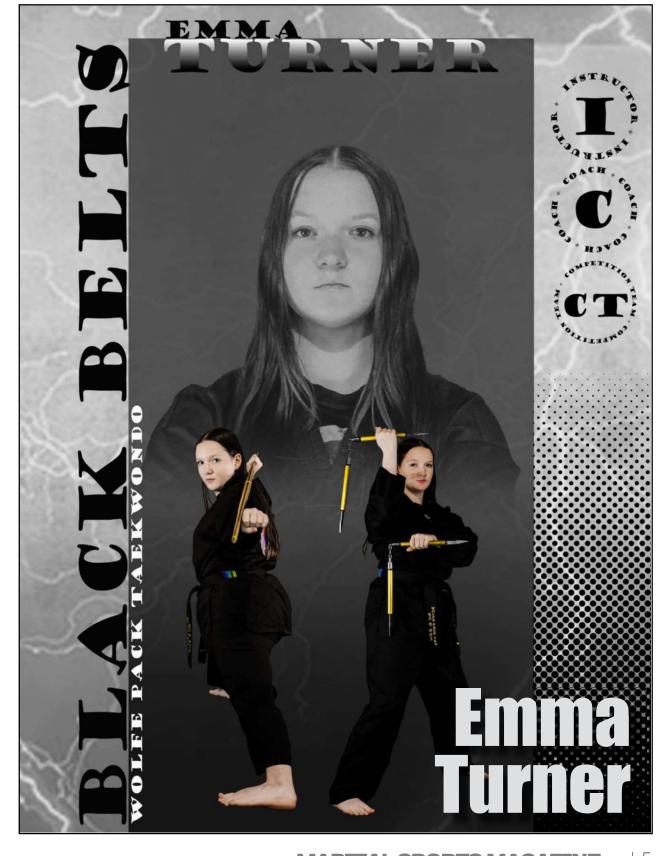
Tyler's mission is to become the best athlete and martial artist he can be,

I started with Capoeira and a short time later I also started with acrobatic karate. I have now practiced both disciplines since then. I practice these disciplines at the "Claudiu Academy" in a town in the province of Treviso and my coach is Sempai Claudiu. I am a Competitive Athlete and I competed in several competitions at national and international level, winning several medals. My specialty is the open hand forms but I hope to be able to compete with weapons as well, especially with kamas.

In 2023 I participated at my first competition "Italian open 2023" ranking first. In the same year I participated in the "golden glove 2023" coming in 4th place, at the "Ikw world cup 2023" I took first place and in the "unified world cup 2023" taking home the gold medal. Nel 2024 In addition to the various national competitions where I have always ranked on the podium. The international competitions where I

participated are again in the "Golden Glove 2024" winning the first position, "Ikw world cup 2024" finished fourth due to a disqualification, "unified world cup 2024" winning 2 gold medals and 1 silver e "point fighting cup 2024" In which I won the bronze medal. In September of the same year I participated in the "Performer cup", a worldwide event in which athletes of scenic arts and circus arts compete, winning the pass for the 2026 European Championships both as an individual athlete and as a team. In January of this year I participated in Chesterfield at the "wtka British open" competition winning 3 silver medals and 1 gold medal and a few weeks ago I reconfirmed myself as world champion at the "Ikw world cup 2025" obtaining first place. The next goal is the reconfirmation of absolute Italian champion and the "Hungarian world cup" in Budapest. My dream is to become a great world champion and to be able to make this sport my job as well. I will open my own gym and I will pass on the teachings I received from my coach. This sport allows me to travel and make new friends from all over the world.

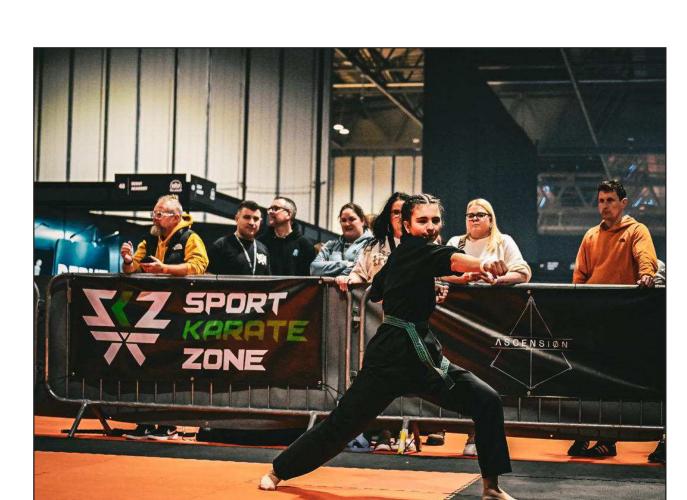












My name is Stefania, and martial arts taught me that success isn't about being perfect - it's about pushing forward, even when it

feels impossible. I've had moments where I wanted to quit, where I doubted myself, but every setback shaped me into who I am today. I was never the fastest, strongest, or most confident, but something

about the movement, precision, and challenge kept pulling me back. Martial arts became more than training - it became a way to test my limits and prove what I'm capable of. Before martial arts, I spent a year in dance. It was a great experience, but it didn't feel right for me. I wasn't sure what to do next. Living in a small city, I didn't have many options, but martial arts

was one of them. At first, I thought it was all about fighting, which didn't interest me. But as I looked deeper, I saw the discipline, skill, and self-improvement behind it. That's when I joined the same club my sister trained at - one focused on forms and performance rather than just fighting.

My journey hasn't been easy. One of my biggest setbacks was a bad landing on a tornado kick that messed up my ankle. The physical recovery was tough, but the mental side - holding back, adjusting my training - was even harder. I've also battled my own perfectionism, constantly feeling like I wasn't good enough, even when I made progress. At times, training felt more exhausting than rewarding.
