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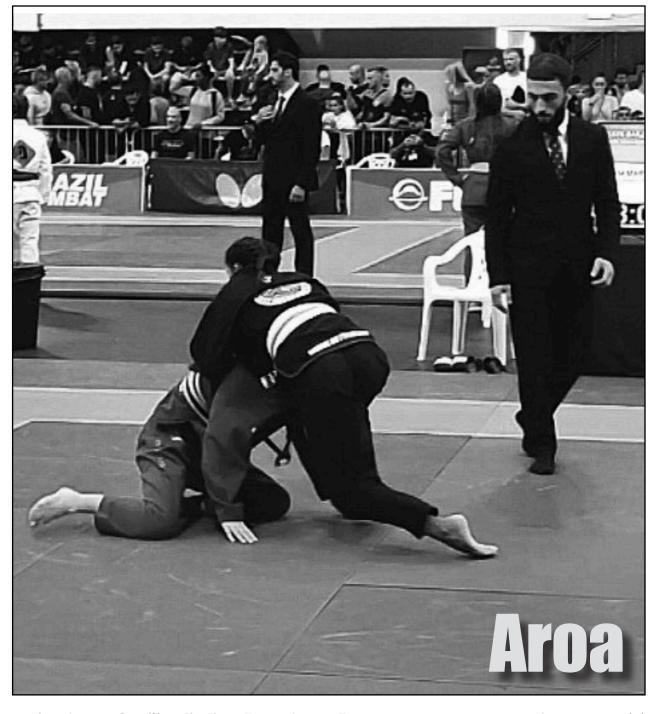

Sus logros hablan por sí solos: campeona de

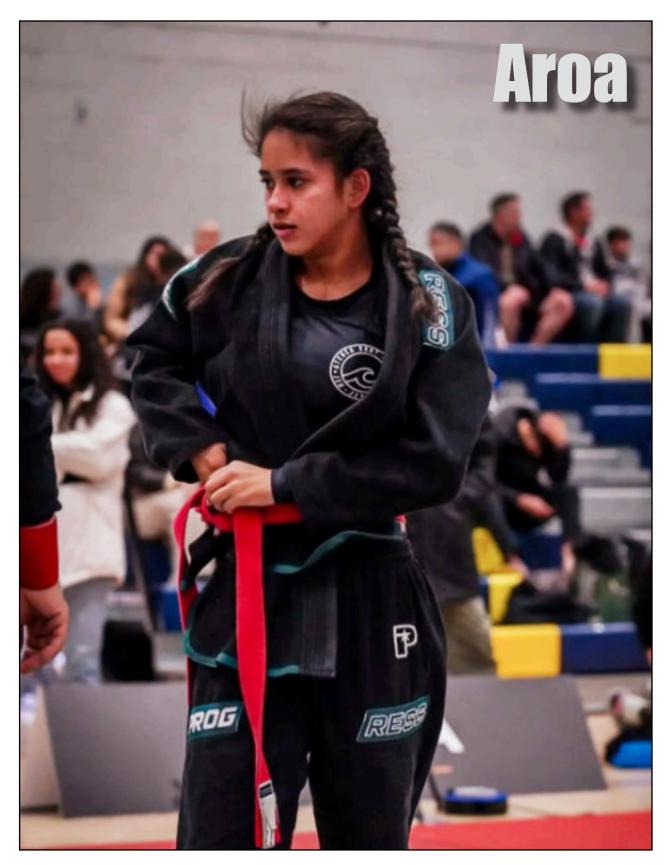

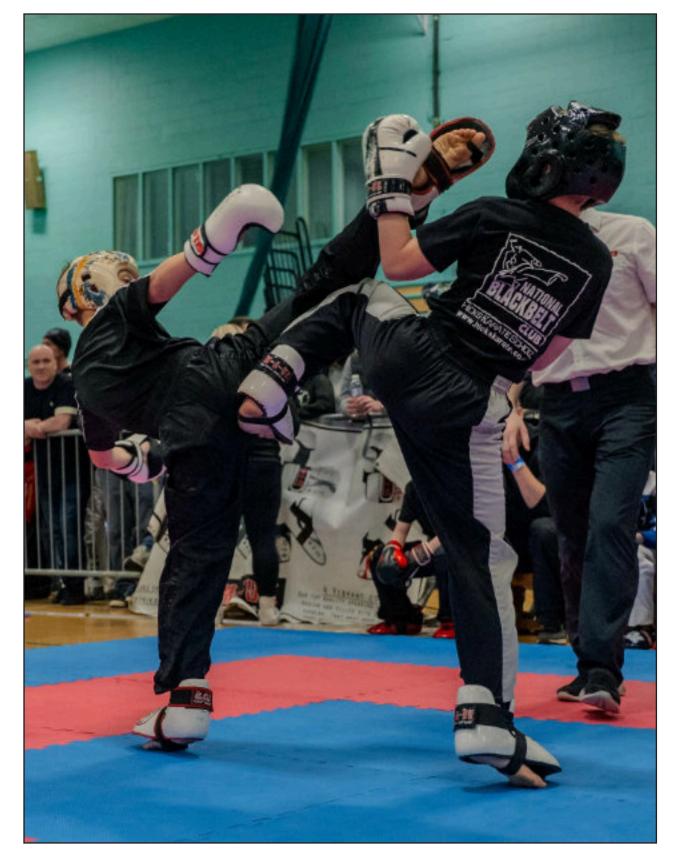
Now training up to 10 hours per week at BKS Martial Arts & Fitness, Jake is part of Team BKS - the club's elite competition team. Under the

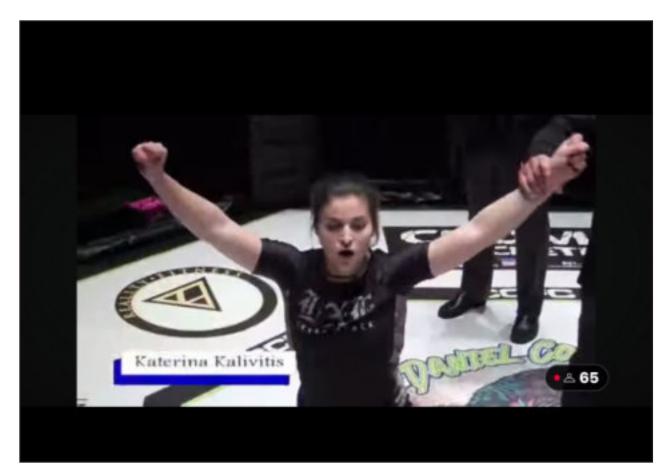

My Jiu-Jitsu Journey: Katerina's Story

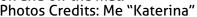

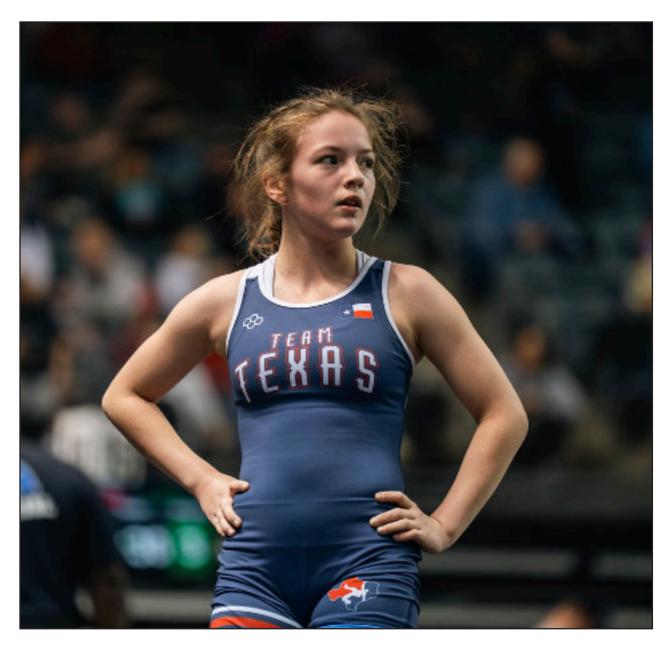












My Name is Leire Smith — Wrestling is My Way of Life

My journey in combat sports began at the age of 7, when I started training in jiu-jitsu with my dad. I earned my gray and black belt, but soon

discovered my heart was in wrestling — the sport I plan to pursue through high school and beyond.

I've now been wrestling for nearly two years and have competed in numerous tournaments. I'm proud to be the 2025 TX-USAW Folkstyle 12U Girls 90lb State Champion and the 2025 TX-USAW Freestyle 14U Girls 90lb State Champion!

One of my biggest accomplishments so far was being selected to represent Team Texas at the

Heartland National Duals in Iowa this past March — a huge honor, especially as a rookie. I was also chosen to compete at the WoW Nationals Duals in Tulsa, Oklahoma, where I earned my first-ever All-American honor.

I'm incredibly grateful for the love and support of my family, my amazing coaches, and my talented teammates who've helped shape my journey so far. This is just the beginning!

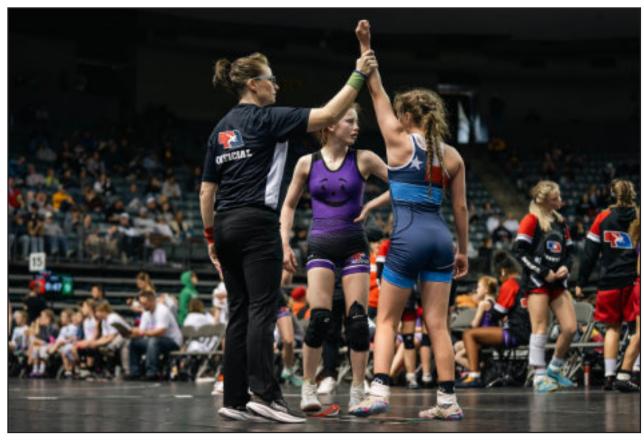

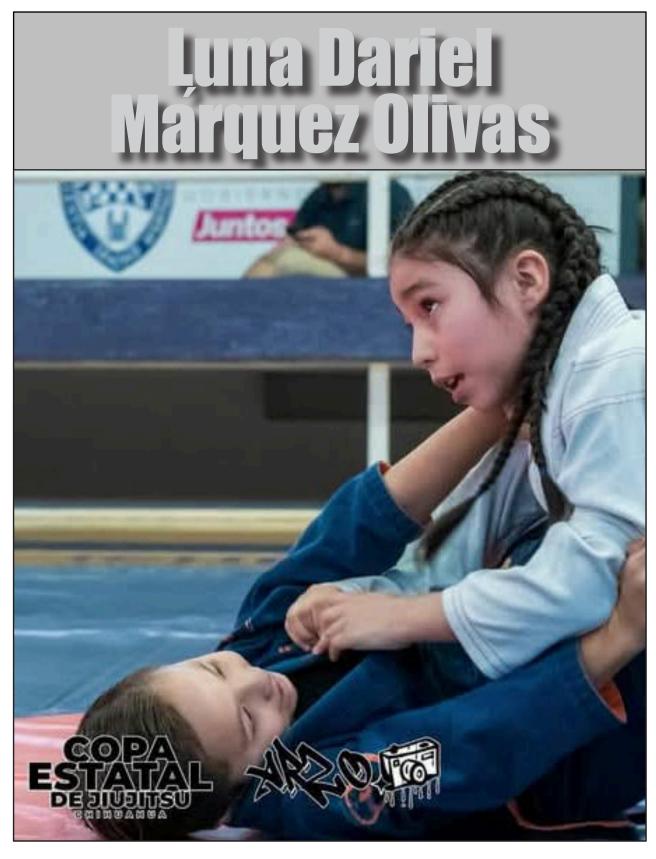

In 2024 alone, I competed in 34 tournaments and had 133 matches.

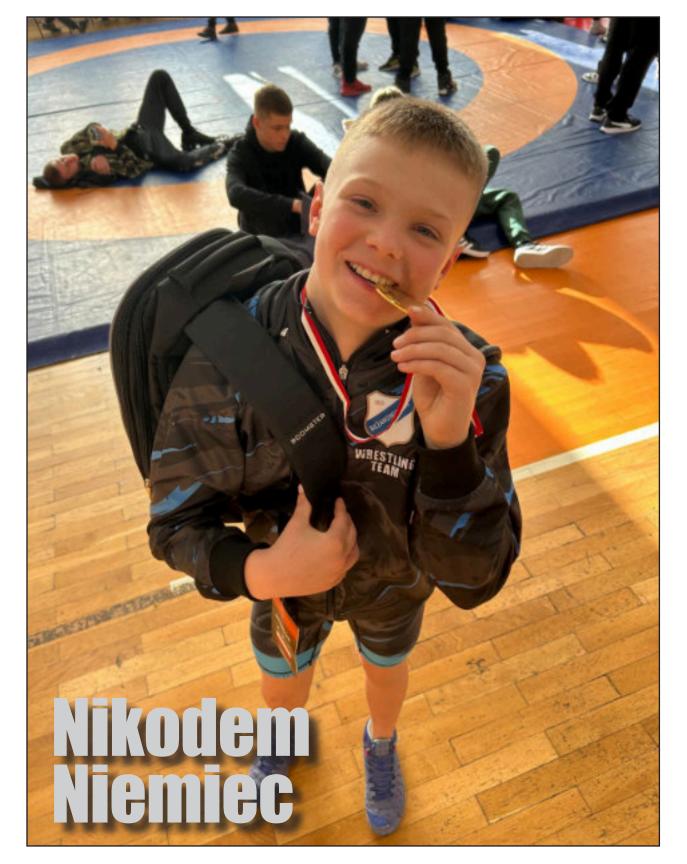
I won 107 of them, including 71 by submission. I earned 22 gold, 11 silver, and 7 bronze medals. Some of my highlights include:

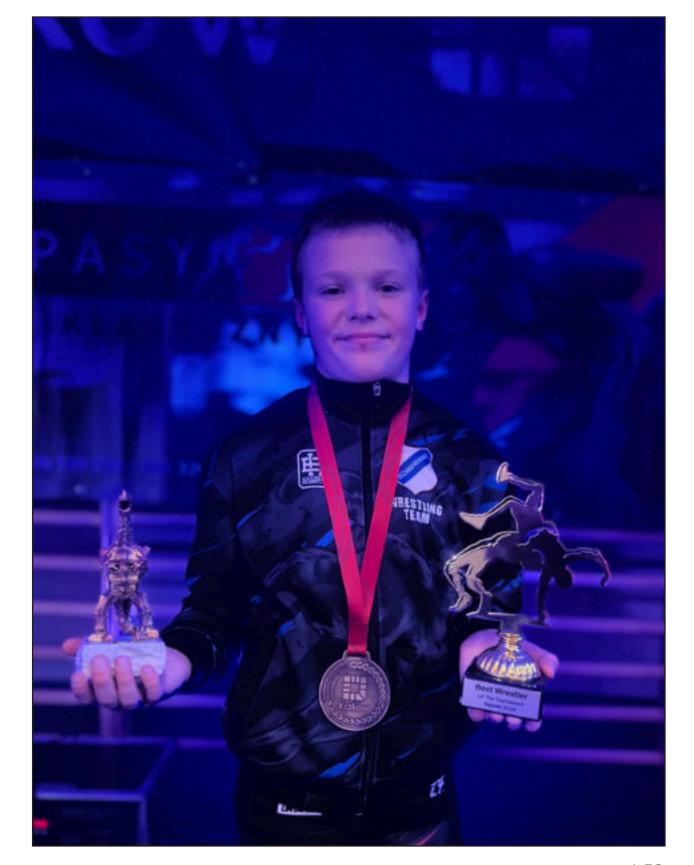
