






I had to give myself Lovenox injections 3 times daily which left enormous bruises all over me.

I started to get into Jet Boat racing ** but, it was hard to find anyone to enjoy it with.

Thought about getting a Rickter to do some back flips on the flat water and my family all said, "ABSOLUTELY NOT!".

One day my children asked to go






rollerskating. I refused to wear the rental skates. I purchased the cheapest skates available.

I went out onto the floor and IIMMEDIATELY knew that this was it. This was my new thing.

I skated as a child. Was decent at it. Only cared about winning the races. I had no idea that I had all the potential inside of me that I have now unlocked for the entire world to witness.

My Mother is in the record books for Rollerskating. Her name used to be in the skate floor in Alexandria, IN before they closed that rink. She went to Worlds at the age of 9 I do believe. Her Skating Partner (Whom will remain nameless) is a multiple Gold Olympic Champion on ice.

I have people trying to get me onto the next season of Rollerjam on HBO.












Chloé Mckinnon Clift





My name is Lexie, I'm 12 and I live and train in France. I have been regional champion in my age/catagory twice and I currently skate at National


level here in France. My goal is to skate for Ireland in the future and help promote skating there.




